Timothy & Sarah Rogers came to Newmarket from Vermont in 1801. He brought with him 20 (40 ?) other Quaker families. After Newmarket became settled, he moved to Pickering Twp. (1807), where he built a saw and grist mill on Duffin's Creek. (1810). The mills burned down in 1956. The saw mill was located on Duffin's Creek, just south of the present Highway 401 and the railroad bridge overpass.

They had 15 children: 8 sons, 7 daughters.
