**Teen 'mobs' terrorize plaza**

PICKERING - Frustrated merchants of a Pickering plaza overrun by crowds of students had a shattering experience recently when a youth fell through a plate glass window into a dental office.

The incident is the latest in a series to upset Maple Ridge Plaza business owners, who say they're losing customers because of the swarm of students who gather at the Liverpool Rd. site. Hundreds of youths pass by the plaza

daily on their way to and from nearby schools. "People are all complaining to the (plaza) stores they don't want to come there unless they're escorted through these mobs of kids," says Valerie Lorenz, who works with her hus-

band Fred at Ultimate Dental Services, where a window was broken by a teenager who told police he "fell backward" while sitting on an outside ledge.

Fist fights, litter, merchants pelted with pizza and threatened with break-ins are also cited as problems by business owners, police and Town politicians.

"It's of genuine concern to the Town," says Durham Regional Police Inspector Tony

**Ajax woman gets life for accountant's 'execution'**

AJAX - A 24-year-old Ajax woman has been sentenced to life after pleading guilty to second-degree murder in the 1991 slaying of an accountant.

Tracey Armstrong won't be eligible for parole for 12 years, Justice John McIssac ruled Friday in Whitby provincial court. He also prohibited Miss Armstrong from ever possessing firearms.

Calling the crime "a diabolical plot, a contract killing", he noted that Miss Armstrong had shown remorse and had co-operated with police in their investigation.

Crown attorney Frank Giordano said the people who plotted the "execution-style murder" in essence "played God. They decided to terminate (an) individual."

The body of North York accountant Harry Feige, 35, was found slumped over the wheel of his blood-splattered car on Oct. 10, 1991. He had been shot several times and was found by a passerby on Conc. 6, just south of Regional Rd. 21 on the Pickering-Uxbridge border.

Miss Armstrong and Deborah Feige, the wife of the victim, were arrested in January, 1992 and charged with first-degree murder.

Mrs. Feige, reportedly dubbed the "Black Widow" by police, pleaded guilty to second-degree murder in April. She must serve a minimum of 14 years before becoming eligible for parole.

Last month, three Toronto men were arrested in connection with the case.

The court imposed a ban on publication of further details of the case.

# Dump the NDP and export trash, north urges

**Government may be ousted before new dump opens**

DURHAM - The NDP provincial government will have to be voted out of office before alternatives to landfill can be examined.

That's the opinion of a coalition of northern Ontario communities willing to accept Metro's trash and dump it down a mine shaft for economic benefits. Calling themselves the Impact North Coalition, the communities of Kirkland Lake, Englehart and Larder Lake hosted a Queen's Park press conference Wednesday, urging the provincial government to reconsider its stance against garbage export.

The coalition wants permission to conduct an environmental assessment on Kirkland Lake's Adams Mine, proposed as a recycling and solid waste site that would take Metro's trash and pump money into the northern area's depressed economy.

But no one from the NDP government showed up at the press conference, says Don Studholme, Kirkland Lake's director of economic development and tourism. Both the Liberal and Progressive Conservative caucuses have indicated their support of an environmental assessment on the mine, he adds, and the coalition is confident another government will be in power before three new dump sites in the Greater Toronto Area — including one in Pickering — receive final approval.

"We're feeling very confident. If we have to wait them out, we'll wait them out," he says of the NDP. "We have all intentions of seeing this through to the end."

The coalition would like the support of southern Ontario residents in trying to sway the government's position on garbage export, he adds. "We will con-

tinue to proceed with whatever we can do."

That includes continuing to co-operate with interested cities

and communities by explaining the Adams Mine proposal and

welcoming visitors to tour the site, Mr. Studholme says.

# Police plaza patrols 'band-aid solution'

Turner, recently of 25 Division in Pickering and now stationed at police headquarters in Oshawa. "Some citizens are afraid to go to the plaza. The root of the problem is there are so many kids going to school and so many kids coming from school and they're congregating at the plaza."

Police have stepped up enforcement with regular patrols of the area, but that's "a band-aid solution," he adds.

Contributing to the problem are a bus stop near the plaza, traffic congestion and the sheer number of students due to the nearby schools Pine Ridge Secondary, St. Isaac Jogues and Maple Ridge Public School, Town officials say. A meeting was called recently to discuss the issue, with those in attendance including school board representatives, Town councillors, police and parents.

The bus stop will likely be moved to help alleviate student congestion, says ward councillor Eileen Higdon. She also hails police presence and more garbage pails in the area as solutions.

"The concern is it could take months; it could be spring before we get these suggestions implemented. It's very frustrating because school teachers only have jurisdiction as far as school property goes."

Only a small percentage of students are causing problems and the image of Pine Ridge Sec-



ondary School is suffering as a result, she says. "That neighborhood does not feel good about that high school."

Students at Pine Ridge have been lectured on how to behave, says principal Jim Weaver. "Most of the problems have been after school hours. I really have no authority. We've talked to the kids about how to behave, we've done an environmental cleanup of the site and we're going to do another one."

School officials also check the plaza for students skipping classes, he adds. "It's been extremely good this year."

Ron Baruch, vice-president of



business and legal affairs for plaza owner Vinjohn Developments, says he sat in his car at the plaza between 3 and 4 p.m. on two days and found the situation "unbelievable".

The bus stop should be moved away from the plaza, he maintains. "People are refusing to come to our plaza. It's not the tenants' fault and it's not our fault."



His company is "going through the proper channels" by working with Town council to solve the problem, but the matter is now in the hands of politicians, he says. "I made the suggestion (to move the bus stop); it's not up to me. They're looking at it already."



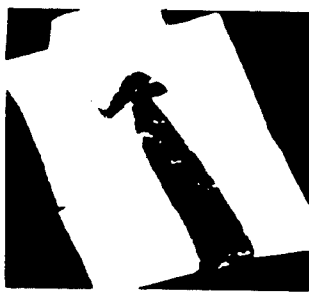

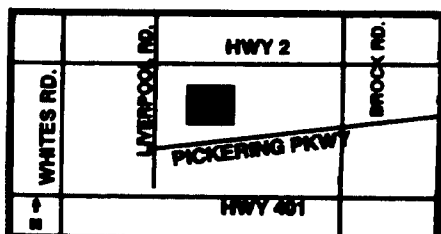

# Passionate plea to save school programs for disabled

DURHAM - Taking the axe to school programs aiding students with disabilities would be a mistake, Durham Board of Education Trustees were told Tuesday night.

A visually-impaired student and the father of a child with a learning disability were among several people to address trustees during a public consultation meeting on the public board's upcoming budget deliberations.

"The great thing about the Academic Resource program is that each student receives individual attention," said Chris Maley, a visually-impaired student at Dunbarton High School. Teachers in the Academic Resource program ensure his notes and exams are photocopied and enlarged so he can keep up with his lessons, he explained. "I understand that cuts have to be made, but don't cut a program that has been so successful."

The board may revamp or cut 34 programs and services in an estimated budget of \$380.4 million. Without cuts, its supporters face a tax increase of 6.71 per cent next year.

Proposed for the chopping block are nine speech and language pathologists and a number of counsellors, social workers and supply teachers. Kindergarten programs could be revamped to eliminate the need for noon-hour busing, the future of a French immersion program is up in the air, and gifted students may face changes to their programs.

Changes or cuts are also proposed in a number of other areas, including instrumental music and family studies and design technology for Grades 7 and 8 students, outdoor education, prologue for the performing arts and computer classroom programs.

Mr. Maley told trustees the help of Academic Resource teachers has enabled him to achieve marks that reflect his ability. "In my academic career, this was the best feeling and attitude I had ever had; my self esteem rose, my anger went away and I was making plans for university."

Parent Dave Tunstead, whose daughter has a learning disability, said it would be "short sighted" to

consider cutting programs that offer students the basics in education.

The board's Learning Strategies program allows students to work on

reading, writing and arithmetic, he pointed out. "It is with this extra help that they are able to achieve better marks in all of their classes as,

without these, they will never cope. Learning Strategy students are taught to cope in the real world, not isolated from it."

## Town council to debate spending on Altona Forest

PICKERING - How much money, if any, the Town should spend on preservation of the Altona Forest will be debated by Pickering councillors Monday.

At least \$3.8 million is needed by the Metro Toronto and Region Conservation Authority to buy 21 acres of the environmentally-significant site, and the agency expects Pickering to chip in.

To date, 110 forest acres have already been bought by the MTRCA with a \$10-million cheque written by the provincial government. The acquisition project has saved the forest from becoming a subdivision.

Pickering should shell out \$3 for every resident annually for the next four years, for a total of \$834,000, suggests councillor Kip Van Kempen, the Town's representative on the MTRCA. He says the money could come from a parkland reserve account and therefore wouldn't cause any tax hike.

"To date, Pickering has contributed nothing," he points out in a press release. "A meaningful contribution from Pickering, which is the benefiting municipality, is critical to set the pace for others to similarly contribute."

The MTRCA will be seeking financial help from other levels of government, the conservation foundation and citizens' groups, he says.

The Town treasurer has suggested Pickering contribute \$400,000 to the project, in a report that was tabled by council earlier.

Mayor Wayne Arthurs says the issue should prompt hot debate. The Town, when approving a subdivision in the forest, was interested in preserving 19 hectares as an urban forest, he points out. "I feel no particular obligation to acquire additional property the Town has no interest in."

The mayor adds he "would be interested to see how much the MTRCA puts into the pot."

But he refused to say exactly how he'll vote, pointing out he hasn't read any resolutions and saying he prefers to debate the issue in chambers rather than in the newspapers.

After council's executive committee deals with the issue Monday, it will be before council for consideration Dec. 20.

## The write stuff or the right stuff?

We have some good news and some bad news. The good news is that our average youngsters have writing skills better than their peers in the rest of the Province.

The bad news is that our brighter teens don't measure up to advanced students throughout Ontario.

The news came this past week when we learned the results of provincial tests of writing by Grade 12 Durham Board of Education students. Advanced or bright teens aren't writing at acceptable English standards while those at the basic and general (average) levels exceed expectations.

What should we make of the results? Should we panic that our best students aren't so great and call for more emphasis on at least one of the basics of education -- writing? Or should we sit back content that our average teens are better than average? Neither would be the correct approach.

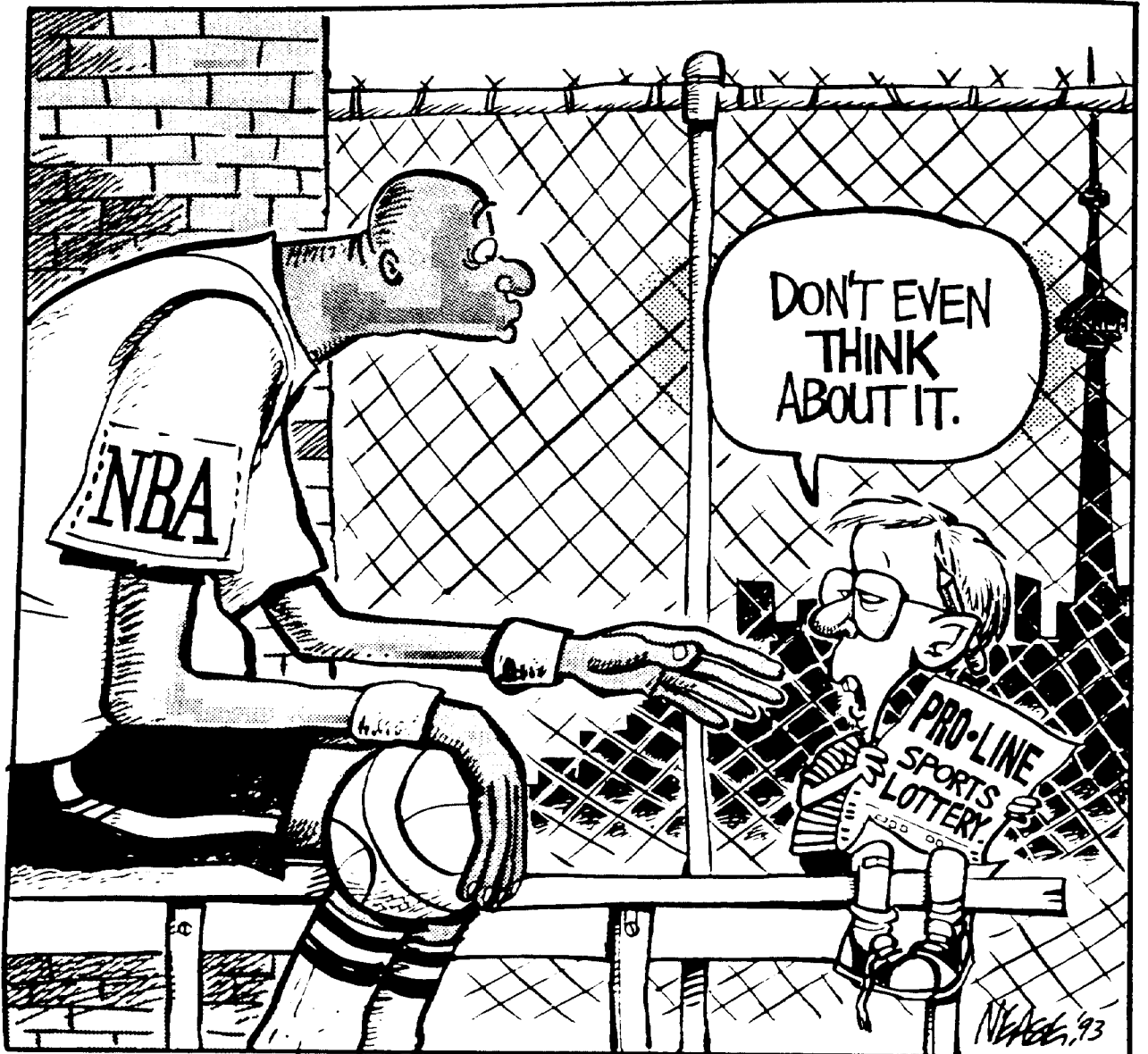
The Durham Board of Education knows what approach it's taking. Each of the region's public secondary schools will develop a separate action plan based upon individual results from the study. Because the study revealed that advanced students seem to do better writing at home where they may have access to a computer and reference material, one of the main components of those plans will be the increased use of computers in the schools.

That's a sensible approach...to a point. If students do better work on computers, it makes sense to ensure computers are available in schools. But, cash-strapped schools and over-burdened taxpayers can hardly afford to shell out any more money to buy such equipment.

Instead, maybe the educators should look at the flip side of what the tests show and what a board facilitator believes -- that environment seems to be a significant factor in the quality of the advanced students' work. As revealed in the test results and as stated before, bright teens appear to do better work in the home than they do in the classroom because they prefer working at home.

The facilitator will only say that the students' preference for working at home "may" be due to the presence of computers there. Or, perhaps it can be attributed to the presence of something ominous in the classroom.

If there is something wrong in the classroom, it must be set right...before educators can properly address bright students' sub-standard writing.

# The blizzard of '92 recalled

PICKERING - A year ago today, Pickering residents were cursing Mother Nature and the snow she'd buried us under.

A record snowfall Dec. 11 turned southern Ontario into a winter wonderland or, more appropriately, a winter blunderland. It made driving treacherous at best; closed schools, businesses and other non-essential facilities and services; and gave just about everyone with a driveway a pain in the lower back.

Snowplow operators in Pickering were attacked with shovels and verbal abuse, and a few people faked medical emergencies in an effort to lure snow-clearing crews to their streets. Thousands of calls were logged at the Pickering Civic Complex, where mayor Wayne Arthurs and other senior personnel manned the switchboard.

Town staff were on the streets "pushing cars out of the way," recalls Tom Quinn, executive director of operations. "Looking back, I feel a lot of the criticism of the Town was very unjust."

It was mid-summer before all the storm damage was repaired.

"We're not allowing it to snow anymore," jokes Mr. Quinn.

The Town has re-examined its after-hours emergency plan in the wake of last year's storm, he adds. While no new equipment or staff have been added for another major storm that might not occur, steps that have been taken include:

- An inventory of both Town equipment and privately-owned equipment that could be available to aid Pickering's snow-removal operations;

- The training of additional staff to act as "wing men" on snowplows, riding in the passenger seat of the machines to keep an eye out for obstructions on streets. This allows plows to operate 24 hours if necessary, because it prevents two qualified plow drivers from having to double up in machines on the same shift, which tires both licensed drivers at once;

- The designation of the recreation complex as a place where tired emergency staff can get some sleep or take a shower, instead of having to commute home and run the risk of getting stuck or into an accident;

- Abandoned or stuck cars will be towed to clear the way for plows

People faked medical emergencies to get their streets cleared. Others attacked snow plow operators with shovels and verbal abuse.

and other equipment;

- The Town will work more closely with the media during emergencies, advising residents of

problems through radio and television reports;

- More staff members have been trained to use switchboard equip-

ment so they can pitch in and handle telephone calls during emergencies;

- There is better co-ordination

and efficiency between the departments of fire, transit and public works with the appointment of Mr. Quinn as director of operations overseeing all of those areas;

- Cases of faked medical emergencies will be investigated and the Town will "seriously consider legal action if staff feel there's sufficient proof," says Mr. Quinn.

# Cops go back to the classroom

## New learning centre provides police officers training in new techniques

DURHAM - Although Durham Regional Police aren't officially opening their new Learning Centre at Durham College until today, the verdict on the new facility is already in.

That's because the centre has been working out of its new location since September and centre instructor Sgt. Alan Mack reports, everything has turned out even better than expected.

"What we've gained overall are the resources we can now tap into," says Sgt. Mack.

The centre now has its own skills development area to teach officers techniques in such areas as self-defence and proper use of a police baton and handcuffs. It also has access to as many classrooms as it needs, as well as the college's library, gymnasium, equipment, and the expertise of college staff. Of particular advantage has been access to the resources used in the college's law and security courses.

Before the move, the training centre was operating out of the cramped confines of the second floor at 18 Division headquarters in Whitby. The only facilities there were a classroom and some administrative space. Skills development sessions were usually held at the McLaughlin armories in Oshawa.

Most of us probably have the idea that police training is for cadets only. But for all officers at all levels, training is a continuous, and endless, process.

For example, each year all officers have to be re-certified in CPR techniques. If there are changes in legislation that affect law enforcement, those have to be taught to officers and often civilian staff as well. New initiatives such as community policing require the training of officers, and police also receive instruction in areas such as defensive driving.

In 1994, notes Sgt. Mack, every one of Durham's approximately 585 uniformed officers will have to be retrained in the use of force procedures (such as the use of handcuffs, the baton and handguns). The retraining has been mandated by the provincial government. And currently centre staff are going through the process of training officers in the use of pepper spray, a weapon recently adopted by Durham police. No officer is allowed to use it until he or she is trained.

With the new centre, the Durham force's staff of eight trainers — all of them police officers — will be able to undertake some innovative programs not

possible before.

"It's opened up the door to computer-based learning for us," says Sgt. Mack.

He explains computer-based learning would allow officers to take courses through a computer program at their own offices at times convenient to them, instead of incurring the cost and time involved in getting officers together into a classroom for a course.

The centre also trains civilian staff and auxiliary officers (civilians who volunteer their time to help police).

The only thing that can't be provided at the centre's new home is training and refresher courses involving the shooting of firearms.

Durham police have been renting shooting ranges in the region for firearms training. Consideration is

being given to establishing a shooting range at the college some time in the future.
