## Beware of look-alike hydro bills, Pickering warned

PICKERING — Pickering Hydro has issued an alert urging customers to be wary of what appear to be hydro bills received through the mail but are not.

The local utility has already received at least a dozen complaints from its commercial customers about the look-alikes.

"Similar bills were being issued to customers in Ajax three or four weeks ago," reports George Armstrong, manager of cus-

tomers relations for Pickering Hydro. "Now they seem to have sprung up here."

The "bills" are from a company called Ontario Energy-Electric and look much like a hydro bill. They even include a logo similar to the Ontario Hydro electrical plug logo. The

mailing address listed for Ontario Energy-Electric is a post office box in Toronto. The bills have been sent to named businesses here at their correct addresses, requesting payment

## Lost Boys' loved ones hold lakefront vigil 'sending God plea to end living nightmare'

PICKERING — A quiet, candlelight vigil Sunday afternoon on the Lake Ontario shore at the foot of Liverpool Road in Pickering will mark the day exactly one year ago that six area teenagers disappeared.

Ribbons will be tied to a shoreline tree, balloons released up toward the heavens and flowers dropped into the lake as parents, family members, and friends of 'The Lost Boys'

"send a message to God" asking for an end to the "living nightmare" that began March 17, 1995.

Whether it's the miracle they pray for every day or the harsh reality which none could ever prepare for, Marie Smith of Pickering simply wants answers to the tragic, year-old mystery.

"The hardest part is just not knowing," says Ms. Smith, whose son Chad, at the time 18, was one of the six boys who vanished. "I would have been able to take the death of my son easier than him missing. At least then you can try to end the pain, but you can't end the unknowing."

"We want some closure, but to be honest we're also scared of closure. A lot of us still have hope," says

## Problems continue to plague Pickering reactor

PICKERING — The return to operation of the Unit 2 reactor at the Pickering Nuclear 'A' Generating Station has been delayed due to some minor problems.

After being shut down for 14 months following a spill of heavy water in the unit in December of 1994, the reactor was scheduled to produce power again by March 6.

"We have started up the reactor and we are running at five-per cent power right now," 'A' station generating units manager Andy Schwabe said Thursday. "It has gone a little bit slower than what we thought. We had a few little things we had to fix."

The restart process began Feb. 15 and was expected to take about three weeks to do all the checking and double checking of systems required before the reactor could be returned to full power.

However, explained Mr. Schwabe, the 14-month shutdown resulted in a few more problems than expected. For example, some seals on valves

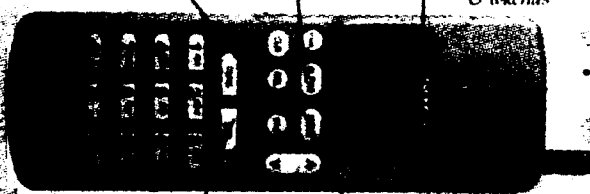

# Education minister's math skills suspect: school board

**DURHAM** — Education Minister John Snobelen's math skills need some work, according to the Durham Board of Education's top number cruncher.

The \$400 million in provincial grant reductions to school boards this year amounts to a seven-per cent education cut — substantially more than the three per cent claimed by the minister.

That's the figure calculated by Brian Cain, public school board superintendent of business.

Subtract \$400 million from the \$5.5 billion the Province allocated to boards last year and the cut works out to seven per cent, notes Mr. Cain.

"The three-per cent figure is really a misleading statistic. (The minister) is combining the total expenditure on education (including school boards' contributions) rather than just taking the \$400 million out of the grants," he contends.

A spokesman for Mr. Snobelen could not be reached for comment prior to Sunday's deadline.

Meanwhile, public and separate school board officials have been punching away at their calculators since Thursday, when the Ministry of Education and Training made public the key financial "piece of the puzzle" on grant reductions.

The preliminary funding figures for the year — final grant allocations to individual boards will be announced March

## Ajax, Pickering drivers in crashes face charges for drinking, drugs

**AJAX-PICKERING** — Two drivers each face drug possession and impaired driving charges following two separate car accidents on Bayly Street in Pickering Thursday.

A 26-year-old Ajax man was charged by Durham Regional Police with drunk driving and possession of marijuana and Psilocybin — found in 'magic mushrooms' — after a collision Thursday morning which left two passengers with minor injuries.

Police say the accused was west-bound on Bayly around 11 a.m. when he lost control of his car and skidded into another vehicle, driven by an 83-year-old Ajax man, who had just turned left from Alliance Road onto Bayly.

A 12-year-old girl from Markham and an Ajax woman, passengers in the car driven by the accused, suffered minor injuries. A one-year-old girl also in the vehicle in a car seat was not hurt.

Neither driver was injured. The Hurley Road man was charged with operating a vehicle with a blood/alcohol level over the legal limit and possession of a narcotic and a restricted narcotic. He was released from custody the same day with the promise of appearing in court.

In the second crash, which occurred around 5 p.m., a 34-year-old Pickering driver failed to yield to traffic as he was turning from a driveway onto Bayly near Liverpool Road, police say.

An eastbound car driven by a 19-year-old West Hill man struck the car, causing \$13,000 damage to both vehicles, police say. There were no injuries.

29 — should be tabulated by officials early next week, when they will be presented to trustees.

With the projected grants now in their hands, as well as the cost-cutting "tools" provided by the minister last week, trustees from both boards will begin to make crucial budget decisions in the coming weeks.

A first budget draft was completed by the public school board in February, which calls for a \$10-million increase in spending, however that will require "a lot of changes" if trustees are to offset the provincial cuts, which will likely fall within the \$10 million to \$12 million range.

The ministry has reduced the per-student spending cap it will recognize (when determining its per cent of funding) from \$4,184 last year to \$4,028 this year for elementary students and from \$5,116 to \$4,920 for secondary students. Both cuts amount to about four per cent.

Mr. Cain says the public board spends about \$1,000 more than those ceilings per student, which it must fund totally.

Clery Smith, business superintendent for Durham's separate school board, says the per-pupil grant reduction will have "a dramatic impact" on the board's decision whether to maintain junior kindergarten and transporta-

tion services.

While trustees have said they are reluctant to do away with JK, "It will be under serious consideration," Mr. Smith says.

"We know it's going to cost us money to cut it out and we know it will cost us money to keep it. It's a matter of what the differential is."

The grant cuts will also directly result in less computers in school classrooms, Mr. Smith says.

Staff will present a report to trustees at Tuesday's special finance committee meeting on the financial impact of dropping or maintaining JK and transportation programs.

for what appears to be energy consumption, and listing the "current" payment amount as well as the "past due" amount.

"They're definitely misleading," says Mr. Armstrong. "If you read the fine print it's actually an offer for energy management services."

The warning issued by Pickering Hydro notes Ontario Energy-Electric has no connection with Pickering Hydro or Ontario Hydro and is not authorized to sell electricity in Ontario. It also advises any customer receiving one of the look-alikes to contact Durham Regional Police and/or Pickering Hydro.

Mr. Armstrong is not aware of any of his customers who may actually have sent the money requested by Ontario Energy-Electric.

"We'd be very interested in speaking to anyone who has paid the invoice," he says, explaining it might help police investigate.

The Ontario Provincial Police issued a news release Wednesday concerning their own investigation into the Ontario Energy-Electric bills. It says the anti-rackets section of the OPP's criminal investigations bureau is looking into "numerous complaints" about them.

"These statements do not require payment," says the OPP release. It also asks anyone who has received one and forwarded the payment requested to contact their local OPP detachment or municipal police service.

us still have hope," says Patty Boyle, whose son Jay was 17 when he and five friends headed down to Frenchman's Bay shortly after midnight and never returned.

As the initial shock and horror eases with each passing month, Ms. Smith says she has become almost numb to the daily emotional suffering.

"I think we're all coping differently. For me it's like I'm still in a fog over the whole thing. It's just been one long year of frustration," she says.

"I'm getting stronger and more determined but it's not getting easier. The thoughts are still there every day. But we are getting stronger."

Whatever unknown fate the six teens have met — each parent to varying degrees maintains some level of hope, albeit fading, of the boys' survival — it's a feeling of helplessness which is perhaps most difficult for parents,

Ms. Smith says.

"I really do believe it's in God's hands now, and there is nothing we can do but pray and think about him (Chad). So that's what we do," she says.

"You can't rush God. You just have to be patient."

Like the bond of friendship the six youths shared when they embarked on the "journey", the ordeal has united the parents and families. The group remains in close contact, dependent on each other to help cope with the pain they share.

In a sense, they are living off the strength of one another, says Ms. Boyle.


"We phone each other quite a bit to talk about what we're going through and meet maybe once a month. We stick closely together," says Ms. Boyle.

"We help support each other," Ms. Smith adds. "We've stuck together this long so we'll stick together until the end."

For Ms. Boyle and her four daughters, attempting to live somewhat of a normal life "is still a daily struggle. We're up and down like a roller coaster. One day is good and the next we're crying all day," she says.

"I wake up every day and it's on my mind and when I go to bed every night it's on my mind. It's all I can think of."

dried out during the shutdown and began to leak during start-up and had to be replaced. So station staff have spent extra time "shaking down all the equipment making sure everything is leak-tight".

Station staff were scheduled to send steam through to the unit's turbines to begin generating some power on Friday, but the reactor is to be shut down one more time for more minor repairs before being started up again. The unit is now expected to be running at full power by March 22 or 23.

# Pickering Harbour Company offers residents free boat launch ramp use

PICKERING — The Town will consider an offer from the Pickering Harbour Company to let residents use its boat launch ramp in Frenchman's Bay for free, says deputy mayor Maurice Brenner.

"The Town would be very foolish not to be interested in any opportunity that would enhance Frenchman's Bay or the waterfront," said Mr. Brenner when asked about the offer made in a letter to Mayor Wayne Arthurs from the PHC. "There will be some discussion, obviously, among members of Council when we meet again Monday."

The PHC offer is for free use of its ramp for three years, as well as parking space for ramp users on PHC property. The letter suggests Town property in the vicinity could also be used for parking.

"Our motivation is we are in the marina business and what more business we can attract down here won't hurt us," said PHC president Harold Hough in an interview. He noted the marina sector is in recession, otherwise his company's parking lot would probably be full and the space unavailable.

Mr. Hough said the PHC's other motivation in offering its facilities is to save Pickering taxpayers some money, particularly since those taxpayers include the PHC. The Town is considering buying the Port Pickering Marina site in Frenchman's Bay for parkland and a boat launch ramp, and reportedly made a \$1.2-million offer which was rejected by the owner.

Mr. Hough admitted the PHC has had its disagreements with the now-bankrupt Port Pickering Marina, to which it used to lease space on the water for docks, but maintains that has nothing to do with its launch ramp offer.

"We want to encourage boat use and we want to encourage Council to spend our dollars in a more responsible fashion."

When the three years are up, he added, the Town will likely have to find a place for its own ramp.

Mr. Brenner said councillors will want to know what's going to happen after the three-year arrangement before making any decision on the offer. He noted any Town action on the waterfront must be part of "a long-term vision".

# No more free GO bus rides for Pickering Transit users

PICKERING — There's both good news and bad news for Pickering Transit riders, but it may all be followed by worse news in the months to come.

The good news is GO Transit has decided to continue its fare integration program, under which commuters with GO passes currently get to ride free on Pickering Transit buses to and from the Pickering GO train station, thanks to a subsidy provided by GO to Pickering Transit. The bad news is GO is reducing its subsidy and Pickering Transit is planning to ask local GO commuters to pay 25 cents to ride its buses to and from the GO station as of May 1.

GO Transit's subsidy to Pickering Transit has been reduced from 37.5 per cent to 25 per cent of each adult fare as of April 30. The Ministry of Transportation of Ontario, which also provides local transit authorities with a subsidy for the GO commuters they carry, has agreed to continue its 37.5-per cent subsidy at least until the end of 1996.

If it's approved by Town Council, the new 25-cent fare for GO commuters is expected to just balance off the \$90,000 Pickering Transit is losing because of the subsidy cut, according to Neil Killens, program supervisor for the Town operations department, which runs the transit service.

Also bad news is that because of changes in the way GO Transit and the MTO calculate their subsidies, Pickering Transit plans to eliminate its \$1.25 discount adult fare, which is now available with a minimum 10-ticket purchase. As of May 1 the tickets will cost \$1.50, the same as the regular adult fare, if Town Council agrees to the increase.

In the past both GO Transit and the MTO calculated their subsidies according to a formula based on a combination of the regular adult fare and the discount adult fare charged by a local transit authority such as Pickering's. But as of May 1, the subsidy will be based solely on the regular adult fare.

"If we didn't increase our adult ticket fare then their level of subsidy would have been reduced in 1996," explains Mr. Killens.

Earlier this year, when GO announced it was cancelling existing fare integration agreements, it was

feared integration subsidies would be discontinued altogether. That may still happen.

"What we're planning on doing, as the fare integration program funding progressively dries up, is to pass that cost along to the people who are benefiting from that service. If they cut back further we'll be raising (Pickering Transit bus fares for GO commuters) at increments of 25 cents."

Pickering Transit, in addition to integration program funding, receives about \$880,000 in provincial operating grants to cover a significant portion of its \$2.7-million operating budget for regular services. It also gets about \$235,000 from the Province to help pay its \$520,000 operating cost for specialized services for the disabled.

## Wheels in motion

The wait is over. More than a year after the tragic death of Angela Worona, the transportation ministry and the provincial trucking association have teamed forces to tackle the problem of truck safety. Truckers say it's not as bad as the media makes it out to be, but all it takes is a quick look at the statistics and a drive down Hwy. 401 to see how owners of small vehicles drive scared. Too often the big rigs intimidate commuters with their strong-arm tactics and sheer size. Every driver of a compact car has horror stories to tell, but none as lamentable as the Worona family. The 31-year-old was killed when a tractor trailer wheel flew off its axle into her car while driving on Hwy. 401 at the Ajax-Whitby border. The death of her sister sparked Theresa Worona to lobby the provincial government to impose stricter rules on trucks. She, and quite likely thousands of drivers across Ontario, breathed a sigh of relief when the training and certification program were announced last week.

The Ontario Trucking Association will spearhead an advisory group which will identify the skills a truck driver needs to adjust air brakes on roadsides, as well as the abilities needed to repair or install truck tires and wheels.

Theresa Worona has it right when she wonders how long it will take this group to make its recommendations. It has, after all, taken four months to set up the group, despite promises from Transportation Minister Al Palladini the process would be enacted immediately.

It's a shame it took two senseless deaths to set the wheels of government in motion.

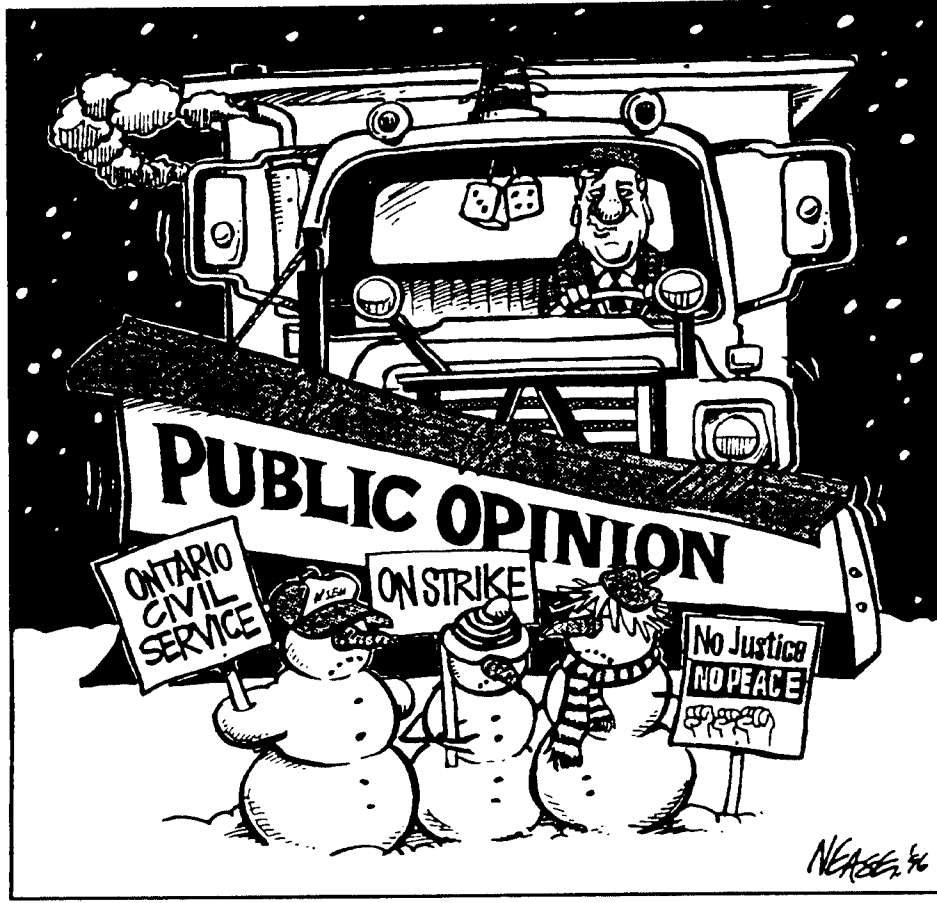

### 'Stress' isn't having prep time reduced

For more than 30 years, I have had close personal contact with numerous school teachers. Although I have never been a teacher, I am one of those who have a better-than-average understanding "of what teachers do."

Absolutely no one of full wit -- especially parents -- would deny that teachers play all-important role in molding and formulating young minds in preparation for the adult world.

Yet, according to Mr. Simpson's letter, on one particular day you and your vice-principal arrived at 7 a.m. and left at 6 p.m. So? Interview some of those hoards of weary commuters at the Oshawa or Pickering Go stations who must commute "miles" to arrive at their work places. It's been exactly one year since these six young men left a party after a night of revelry and simply disappeared. The commonly held belief is that the teens -- rowdy and fearless as boys their age are -- decided to take a boat onto the frigid, unsettled waters of Lake Ontario. And they haven't been seen since.

They left behind friends, family, a young child, and a future that may forever remain unexplored.

One year later, the families still hold out hope while living with the pain of their uncertainty. Police keep the file officially open, but admit there is little chance of finding any of the boys alive.

And here we are, one year later, with many unanswered questions:

Where are these 'Lost Boys'? Why hasn't a single deciding clue emerged in the intervening months to help conclude the case? When will the mystery be solved, one way or the other?

What I find so compelling about this case -- and so many others like it -- is the effect it has had on this community.

Sheerly through circumstance and tragedy, we have seen the drama unfold through the voices of those closest to the boys.

We have seen the private lives of family friends become public lives as they deal with media, organize searches, hold vigils and pay tribute to the memories of their loved ones.

We have seen heart-warming public support throughout Ajax and Pickering, and the use of vast resources from law enforcement and emergency rescue units.

It doesn't make coping any easier -- certainly not for the family members of these boys -- but it does illustrate the character of the community, its belief in the power of hope, its regard for the lives and feelings of others.

We all hold out hope for a happy ending to this story. But we all must prepare for the worst, even as we hope for the best.

The families of these boys deserve a conclusion, for better or worse, so they can get on with their lives.

And, the rest of the community awaits, ready to act accordingly.

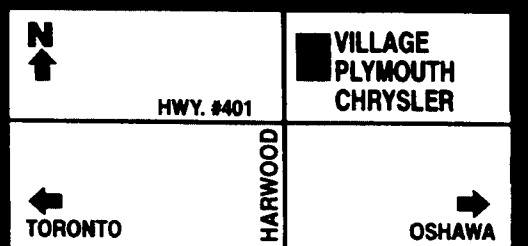

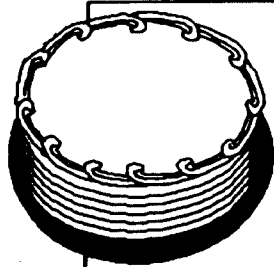

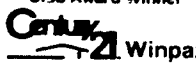

# TAX TIP SPECIALISTS

## EFILE Your Tax Return

If you want your refund quick, EFILE may be the way to go! Most tax returns can be electronically filed and processed in about two weeks. According to Revenue Canada, 94% of people who filed electronically last year had their tax return processed in 10 days or less! There were almost 4 million tax returns EFILE'd last year.

For those unfamiliar with EFILE, it is a way to file your tax return by computer. An authorized EFILE agent can enter your tax return information into their computer and send it directly to Revenue Canada. Since EFILE eliminates the need for Revenue Canada EFILE agents have to be authorized by Revenue Canada to enter your information into their computers, they can process your return in less time.

You should not be worried about your financial information being transmitted across telephone lines to Revenue Canada to send tax returns electronically. Each of the agents have invested a great deal of time and money into the EFILE process. They are also required to use

encryption software to "scramble" your personal information. After it is received by Revenue Canada, your tax return is then "unscrambled" so it can be processed.

You can have your tax return electronically filed three different ways. You can:

- Have your tax return prepared by an authorized EFILE agent.
- Bring in a completed copy of your tax return to be keyed in by an authorized EFILE agent.
- Bring in a diskette with a copy of your

tax return using special tax software.

If you plan to buy tax software, you should first contact an authorized EFILE agent to find out which software they use and also their fee. It might be cheaper to have your taxes prepared and EFILE'd, than it is to buy the software and pay the electronic filing charges; not to mention the trouble of learning the software.

If you would like more information, call a local authorized EFILE agent and they will be happy to answer any questions.



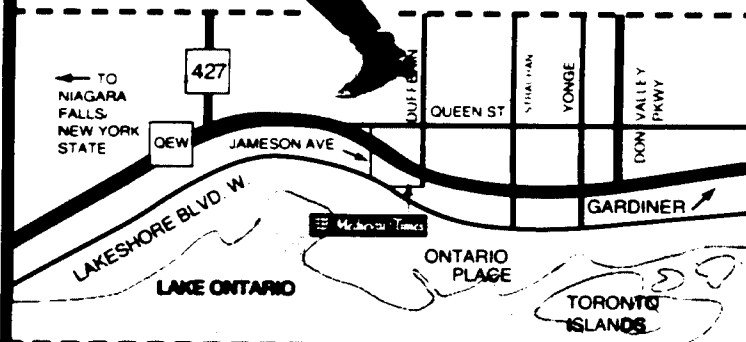

# Ajax GM suppliers forced to lay off several hundred

## U.S. strike puts brakes on local feeder plants

AJAX — Hundreds of workers at four Ajax companies are being laid off because a strike at two brake factories in Ohio has stopped production at several General Motors assembly plants.

Lear Seating director of corporate communication Leslie Touma says the Monarch Avenue plant has been shut down since Tuesday.

"When they go down, we go down," she notes.

Ms. Touma wouldn't comment on the number of workers at the Ajax

plant affected by the shutdown, although one report put the figure at 450. "The facility is down and that's about all the detail we're giving out."

PaintPlas facility manager Helmut Hock reports 300 employees will be laid off for at least a week beginning Tuesday.

The Finley Avenue plant paints parts primarily for GM.

Tarxien Company Limited president Ralph Zarboni says 280 salaried and unionized workers at the Finley Avenue plant were laid off indefinitely Friday morning. The firm also laid off 250 workers at its facility in Concord.

Some 95 per cent of the interior trim Tarxien makes is shipped to the

United States solely for the use of GM, Mr. Zarboni says.

Shutting down production is costing the company \$100,000 a day, Mr. Zarboni adds.

"We don't like it. The negative impact we don't like, but we can handle it," he says.

Custom Racks on Fuller Road has laid off two workers and three more could be off the job if the U.S. strike runs into next week.

United Auto Workers are into the second week of a strike against Delphi Chassis Systems in Dayton, Ohio. The company makes brake parts for GM operations in North America.

# Hair salon chain owner charged with extortion

PICKERING — The owner of a Metro-area chain of hair salons, which includes franchises at the Pickering Town Centre and Oshawa Centre, was charged with extortion Monday following an extensive investigation by Durham Regional Police.

The investigation also resulted in charges of attempting to obstruct justice and conspiring to commit aggravated assault.

The charges involve alleged threats made against a 35-year-old Oshawa man, says Staff Sgt. Sandy Ryrie. The victim was a former salon franchise owner.

Detective John Allan, of the criminal investigations branch, says these charges are "related" to federal tax evasion charges filed

against the accused last year following a year-long joint investigation involving Revenue Canada and Metro Police.

A man was charged in 1995 with 15 counts of tax evasion, allegedly stemming from more than \$2 million in unreported income between 1990 and 1994 in L'Attitudes and Nino D'Arena hair salons.

The maximum penalty the accused faces for the tax evasion charges is five years in prison plus fines of up to 200 per cent of the unpaid taxes. The maximum penalty for extortion is a life sentence in jail.

Charged is Antonio Conforti, 44, of Thornhill. He was released on \$5,000 bail Monday and is scheduled to appear in an Oshawa court March 21.
