Police target Durham Outlaws

Local clubhouse among those raided early Wednesday

AJAX — Residents reacted in a ho-hum manner when the Outlaws Motorcycle Club opened a clubhouse in south Ajax.

Now, following a raid that brought dozens of arrests and turned up numerous weapons and drugs at several Outlaws clubhouses in Ontario, that doesn't seem to have changed.

The raids, conducted by several police organizations, including the Durham Regional Police, RCMP and OPP, were conducted early Wednesday morning. Heavily armed Durham police officers were on the scene at the Ajax location.

Dubbed Project Retire, the raids resulted in the arrests of 35 members of the Outlaws, four former members, and three Black Pistons, known as associates of the Outlaws. Charges include attempted murder, along with drug and weapon offences. None of the arrests came in Ajax.

In addition, warrants are outstanding on four other Outlaw members.

Project Retire was a three-year investigation involving 14 police services and more than 500 police officers.

The Outlaws opened its Ajax clubhouse at 855 Westney Rd. S. during the summer. The club rented space at the rear of the building.

"I haven't even seen them," said Cindy (who refused to provide her last name), who works in a nearby business. "I know they're there. I'm not sure if

New Durham headquarters raises questions

DURHAM — Oshawa may have to wait to get answers to the detailed questions the City has on the proposed \$70-million regional headquarters.

Oshawa city manager John Brown sent several questions pertaining to the new headquarters, which is currently undergoing a request for proposal (RFP) process, to the Region's chief administrative officer. The Region issued an RFP Sept. 10 to five companies following approval by regional council to proceed in July. At that time, however, several details, including the size of the building, were left undecided.

But the City won't get an immediate response to its inquiry if regional council passes the recommendation of its finance and administration committee, which has suggested the answers will be evi-

dent at the end of the RFP process. Oshawa, like all other municipalities, should wait until the RFP results are compiled, committee members determined.

"This is nothing to do with just Oshawa. Every resident in Durham Region will be paying for this," said Uxbridge Mayor Gerri Lynn O'Connor. "The answers will come out as part of the process."

But Oshawa Councillor Clare Aker said the problem for Oshawa is trying to get information out to the public about the project when there is no definitive information on key issues such as the size of the building.

"The concern for Mr. Brown is conflicting information. He wanted to make sure he is reporting with clear information. The fact these questions can't be answered very quickly is a concern. Council should know this. The RFP should be very clear."

Some of the questions Oshawa has asked include:

- What size is the Region proposing in the RFP for the new administrative building;
- What are the current projections on the floor space required for future growth;
- What is the proposed capital cost of the building (estimates range from \$50 million to \$70 million);
- Does the capital cost include furniture, technology and equipment;
- What is the existing cost for lease and rental of buildings;
- How many regional offices will be consolidated into the new building;
- What will the tax impact be and how does the Region propose to pay for additional costs related to the building, including total estimated debt, debenturing and tax increases.

After approval by regional council for an RFP in July, there were no further reports detailing this information brought back to council.

Jack McCorkell, the Region's Commissioner of Works, says a detailed study was conducted by staff over the summer on the needs of each department. Based on this study, it was determined the RFP should be for a 290,000-square foot building not including a possible additional 40,000-square foot extension for police services.

The size was never brought back to council for approval because "we felt we were within the guidelines approved by council," explains Mr. McCorkell.

The final submission date from the five firms invited to submit a proposal is Nov. 10. Mr. McCorkell says he expects a report back to council with the submissions before Christmas.

they're around during the day." She added, "Some people aren't happy, but they haven't bothered me."

Gary, who also works in the same building, hasn't had a problem.

"I wouldn't even know they're there," he said.

A nearby resident, who didn't want to be identified, said, "I did hear them one time. I heard all the motorcycles and I wondered what was going on. Goodness, it's scary when you hear all those motorcycles."

Another resident noted, "I only saw them once, when they came into town one Saturday. They came as a group."

One man said, "I hear the bikers the odd time. I'm not happy it's a biker gang. They don't stand for all the virtues of society. I don't want my kids making contact with them. I'm sure most people in south Ajax

feel the same way."

The landlord for the property where the clubhouse is located wouldn't comment on the situation.

The Outlaws are a longtime enemy of the Hells Angels, which has a clubhouse in Oshtawa.

The Outlaws and Hells Angels are two of four internationally recognized biker gangs, the other two being the Bandidos and Pagans.

There are about 70 members of the Outlaws in 10 Ontario chapters.

In addition to the arrests, police seized five clubhouses, 11 long guns, 22 handguns, one sawed-off rifle, a sawed-off shotgun, ammunition, blasting caps, gas masks, a sword, body armour, knives and martial arts weapons. Police also said they seized drugs including cocaine, ecstasy, hashish, heroin, marijuana and percaset, with a value of \$156,500.

Don Bell, head of the OPP biker enforcement unit (BEU), said the investigation and raids will significantly impact the Outlaws criminal activities.

"This investigation validates the Ontario law enforcement position that outlaw motorcycle gangs are organized crime and as such are not welcome in our communities," he said. "This further demonstrates Ontario's commitment to the national strategy to combat outlaw motorcycle gangs as police continue to remove jurisdictional borders in their fight against organized crime."

Concurring with that assessment is Dave Crane, an OPP superintendent and chairman of the National Strategy to Combat Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs.

"Project Retire is an excellent example of how the strength of the combined agencies in the BEU is our best weapon against outlaw motorcycle gangs," he said.

Time is right to bring in more nurses

With announcement of provincial funding, human cost too high to delay for months

Members of the Region's finance committee have made the right call in approving as many as 27 new positions for Durham's three nursing homes.

It's still up to Durham council to make the final decision, but it would only make sense to back the committee's decision. With the Province committing \$100 million toward beefed up staffing at homes across Ontario, why not press ahead?

Some on the committee, including Clarington Mayor John Mutton and Pickering Councillor Mark Holland have reservations about approving the hirings.

Their chief worry stems from not including the \$1.8 million expenditure along with all other budget considerations, still months away.

Mayor Mutton cautions the Province has a knack for introducing programs and then pulling out down the road leaving the Region to pick up the shortfall.

But, an immediate need by residents in the three homes, Fairview Lodge in Whitby, Hillsdale Manor in Oshawa and Lakeview in Beaverton, trumps future financial considerations. As Uxbridge Mayor Gerri Lynn O'Connor said, there has been "a human outcry from the people we represent for services for seniors in homes. When the ministry comes forward and is putting money there, it doesn't mean we should be cutting back."

To put hours of service per day, per patient into perspective, Ontario residents currently receive 2.04 hours per day, while the number in Manitoba, for comparison sake, is 2.44. The goal set by the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long Term Care is to hit a three-hour-per-day level.

In Durham, residents at Fairview Lodge received 2.72 hours per day of personal care, which would go to three with additional staffing. Hillsdale Manor would rise from 2.39 hours to 2.65, while Lakeview would jump from 2.28 to 2.51 hours per day of service.

Looking the \$1.8-million gift horse in the mouth also would not reflect well on the Region. As Oshawa Councillor John Gray said, "It would be bad politics when the Province comes out with an extra \$100 million and we contemplate scaling back our funding. It doesn't seem the right thing to do."

Ultimately, simple demographics show the number of seniors in Durham will grow by an exponential rate over the next few decades.

Any time we can add staff to our nursing homes, with payment provided by the Province, it should be an easy decision. We owe our seniors that much.

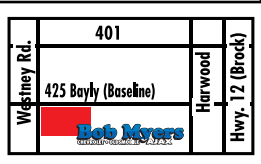

Education task force gets the message again and again

Durham Catholic board has its say in Toronto

DURHAM — After listening to several presentations to the Education Equality Task Force last Wednesday, Mary Ann Martin says chairman Dr. Mordechai Rozanski can only draw one conclusion: publicly funded schools need more funding.

"Everyone is saying more money, equity, special needs need to be addressed, transportation; there was a lot of repetition," the Whitby trustee and Durham Catholic District School Board chairman said in an interview.

Dr. Rozanski is to provide recommendations to Education Minister Elizabeth Witmer in November on how to improve the Province's education funding formula.

Trustee Martin at Monday's board meeting gave trustees a verbal report on how she and education director Grant Andrews fared in delivering the board's presentation.

While a lack of funds was a constant theme amongst boards, she said presenters

varied in how they got their message across.

"I think they really listened to what we had to say because we didn't whine and complain," Trustee Martin told trustees.

In the interview she explained some presenters "were just really aggressive" in pressing home their argument, using props like toilet paper to highlight a lack of money.

She didn't favour a dramatic approach that focused only on criticism.

"I think we wanted them to know all of the good things that came out of the funding formula, but also some of the shortfalls in the funding formula," said Trustee Martin.

As a result, the board in its presentation states, "for the reason of equity and fairness, this board has always supported the student-focused funding model." And while the board in its conclusion said funding employee contracts, special-education needs and other areas "require immediate attention," it also states "the current funding model is equitable, for the most part, for all students and does not require a significant theoretical overhaul."

Instead, the board states information the Province uses to base its funding levels, including benchmarks such as the Consumer Price

Index, needs to be updated.

Ms. Martin said the board is counting on more provincial money.

"When we passed this

(year's) budget we realized the shortfalls we had and we've banked on receiving the money from the government," she said.

The board used almost \$4.5 million in working funds to balance this year's budget and avoid severe cuts.



Durham ITER site gets once-over from international group

DURHAM — They've been here, done that and have the postcards to prove it.

Now international delegates for the ITER (International Thermonuclear Experimental Reactor) proposed international fusion research facility are back home with only memories of their two-week stint in Durham and the GTA.

From all indications the memories will be good ones, says Dr. Murray Stewart, director and president of Iter Canada, the organization leading Canada's bid to host the \$12-billion energy project in Clarington.

"We're very pleased," says Dr. Stewart. "It was a good experience all around. The Canadian strengths came out everywhere: the technical merits of the site, our flexibility and multi-cultural capabilities."

Canada's bid, in competition with three others from Japan, Spain and France, was the first one to undergo the rigorous site-assessment process created through negotiations over the last year. The Japanese site will undergo the same inspections in October followed by assessments on the European sites be-

fore the final assessment reports are submitted in February. A decision on which site will get the nod will probably come in March or April, says Dr. Stewart.

Although the site assessment for Canada is complete, the international parties have agreed to keep the information reports on site selection confidential until all the sites have been evaluated, says Dr. Stewart. "That way if

there is a negative comment, the country has an opportunity to add information or modify their bid," to improve it, he says, explaining it isn't a one-off process like a tender.

Although he cannot reveal how the site scored, Dr. Stewart does say Canada's strong public education system and Clarington and Durham's infrastructure certainly helped the bid. "The qual-

ity of our services is so far beyond what you find in other countries," he says. "For example, we don't propose to build a fire station at the ITER site because the response time from the Bowmanville station is as good as it would be on-site at other locations."

Clarington Mayor John Mutton, who toured with some of the delegations, notes from a socio-economic point of view Clarington is "ahead in leaps and bounds on some of these issues." During a tour of John M. James Public School in Bowmanville, the Japanese delegation was "amazed" to discover it was part of a public education system, the mayor says.

In addition to the site assessment, negotiators from all the project partners - Japan, the European Union, the Russian Federation and Canada - met in Toronto to work out more details of the shared venture.

As well, local dignitaries from Japan and Spain came to visit the Clarington site. Talks also began on the sharing of

the fusion technology that develops through the ITER project.

At a luncheon held at Port Darlington Marina, part of a tour of the Clarington area, Ryuji Sato, chief accountant for the Aomori district, said his time in Clarington was "so meaningful. I have learned so much on the conditions of the location and how Iter Canada and Clarington have welcomed the delegations."

With the sixth round of negotiations poised to begin at the end of October in Japan, Mr. Sato extended invitations to the municipality to visit the Japan site in return.

Meanwhile, environmental and technical studies are ongoing through the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) licensing and regulating process so in the event Canada is chosen, the due diligence will be completed and licensing can proceed.

Further public meetings on the environmental assessment are yet to be announced but will be held prior to licensing.

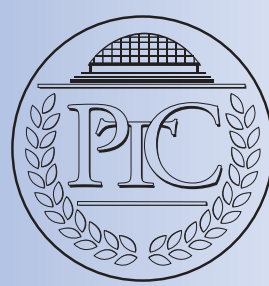

Ajax wants to access helpers for new committee

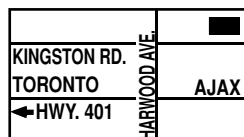

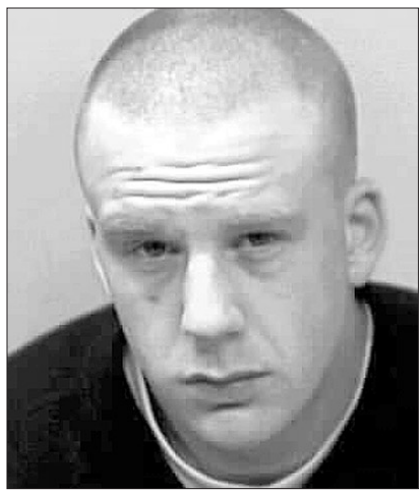

Police seek man deemed 'public safety' risk

DURHAM — A police dragnet is out for a 24-year-old Oshawa man who has led patrol officers on three separate high-speed pursuits in recent weeks.

Residents urged to cut water use

DURHAM — Residents are being asked to cut back on water consumption due to low water levels in the region.

The Water Response Team (WRT) — a group of water management agencies in Durham — is issuing a low water advisory.

Due to a lack of rain over the past three months, water levels are low and stream flow is below historical averages, says Perry Sisson, director of

environmental and engineering services for the Central Lake Ontario Conservation Authority (CLOCA).

Dips in the water levels are not uncommon, Mr. Sisson says, "especially in the last few years."

Last year, the water reserves fell to similar levels but it occurred earlier in the summer season.

Residents should try for a 10-per cent reduction in over-

all water use, Mr. Sisson says. He suggests residents cut back on non-essential uses, both at home and at work.

Some ways to reduce use include sweeping driveways and sidewalks instead of washing them down with a hose and reducing or stopping lawn and garden watering. "Every little bit counts," he says.

In Ward 3, Ms. Haslett was first, 44 Anstead Cres. was second and 31 Harbord Cres. third.

In Ward 4, 36 Bryant Rd. was first, 125 Warwick Ave. second and 28 Davey St. third.

Sauter's Inn and Restaurant on Kingston Road in Pickering Village was the winner in the busi-

ness section, followed by Rendezvous Eatery and Deli in second and IPM Hose and Fittings in third.

Special recognition awards went to Roland Michener Public School and Pine Ridge Memorial Gardens. The special awards were given to honour gardens that don't fit into the usual categories.

Tough start for Lightning

Defending champions hand young Durham squad 10-1 loss

DURHAM — For a Telus Lightning squad still in the formative stages, drawing a season-opening match against the powerhouse Beatrice Aeros was somehow not fair.

The perennial champion Aeros showed no mercy on the Lightning, which has undergone major lineup changes under a new head coach. The result was a crushing 10-1 defeat for the Lightning in their National Women's Hockey League (NWHL) 2002-03 regular-season debut at the Ajax Community Centre Tuesday

night. Far from sugar-coating the result, head coach Peter Perram noted his charges were run over by an Aeros juggernaut complete with a veteran-laden roster that sports several players with international experience.

"They have at least seven national team players alone on that team, so it's always going to be tough to keep them off the scoresheet," said Perram, who was making his league coaching debut. "To pull them in the first game was a little extra challenge for us."

The three-time defending NWHL champions scored three goals before the Lightning got untracked. Telus scored on the power play midway through the first period with Brenda Reynolds getting the goal, from Laura Church and Jamie Hill. It was all Beatrice after that as the Aeros

cruised to a 6-1 lead after one period. The Aeros scored three more in the second and another in the third.

Beatrice outshot Telus 43-13. Because of the veteran nature of the Aeros, Perram said Beatrice is already in mid-season form with strong passing and the ability to create offensively, thanks to an almost uncanny communication among the players.

"They're particularly adept at moving the puck. They have so much familiarity on the ice that you only get through experience. They can almost do it blindfolded," explained Perram.

Putting the defeat into perspective, Perram suggested the Lightning will be even better prepared and better able to compete with the Aeros in future games.

"It's always going to be a challenge to play that team. As the season goes on, I think we'll put up a better fight the next time we play them. They were quite impressed with our club. We're getting some respect and that's important," said Perram.

In a week's time, the Lightning will embark on a road swing through la belle province, playing the Avalanche du Quebec Saturday, Oct. 5 at 7 p.m. The Lightning are then in Montreal to play the Wingstar Sunday, Oct. 6 at 2 p.m.

Perram expects the Lightning to be competitive in both games, and should return home with their first points of the season under their belts, if last season was an indicator.

"In years' past, they were all one- or two-goal games (against the Quebec-based teams), so hopefully we'll take a couple of wins."

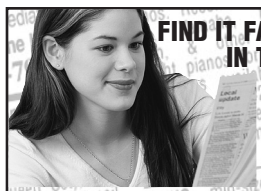


