Frustrations come flooding to the surface

Councillors want concerns addressed

DURHAM — Durham Region will work with the towns of Ajax and Whitby to determine why more than 100 Durham homes flooded in an August storm.

As part of the process, regional staff plan to meet with Ajax residents, by far the most affected by the Aug. 19 rain event. Of the 113 flooded basement calls the Region received, 106 were from Ajax. A number of areas in Pickering were also hit hard by the storm.

At the Oct. 5 works committee meeting, councillors debated the merits of having a public meeting sooner rather than later. Several council members, including Durham Chairman Roger Anderson and committee chairman Marcel Brunelle, argued it was pointless to meet with residents if there was nothing concrete to tell them in

terms of an action plan. But other councillors, including two from Ajax, won the day.

"We're going to sit and wait?" a worked-up Ajax Regional Councillor Colleen Jordan asked when it appeared a meeting could be put off for months. "The anxiety level is very high and we need to talk to the people and tell them what we're going to look at, what is the town of Ajax going to look at."

Oshawa Regional Councillor Nester Pidwerbecki had moved that a meeting be arranged "as soon as possible." However Brock Mayor Keith Shier and Ajax Regional Councillor Scott Crawford said that wasn't good enough.

"It is open-ended," said Coun. Crawford. "As soon as possible could be May 2006."

He accepted Mr. Anderson's amendment that the meeting take place before the end of the year. Before that happens, regional staff

UOIT energized by \$10-million donation

OPG investment aims to fill void of retiring energy workforce

DURHAM — Recognizing the need for a future generation of energy specialists, Ontario Power Generation (OPG) has announced a \$10-million investment in the University of Ontario Institute of Technology's (UOIT) capital campaign.

The funding -- to be provided in \$2-million installments annually over a five-year period -- aims to provide students at the university with the latest technologies, and

high-end labs to acquire the skills they need to succeed in the energy sector of the future.

"Over the next decade, (we) will be challenged with helping the Province meet an ever-growing need for electricity at the very same time we experience as much as 50 per cent attrition in our skilled workforce due to retirements," OPG president Jim Hankinson said at the announcement at UOIT on Oct. 6.

"This investment is an integral part of our succession plan to ensure we have the best-prepared candidates available to replenish our knowledge-based, skilled workforce."

In recognition of the investment, the new engineering building will

be named the Ontario Power Generation Engineering Building. There are nearly 700 students enrolled in UOIT's engineering degree programs, Mr. Hankinson said, and from a business standpoint, investing in UOIT and Durham College made sense.

"These academic institutions benefit from being close to OPG's nuclear facilities and the expertise of our employees," he said. "We benefit from being close to a large pool of career-ready graduates that these institutions and their programs provide. This helps OPG, but it also helps the energy industry, this community and everyone in Ontario."

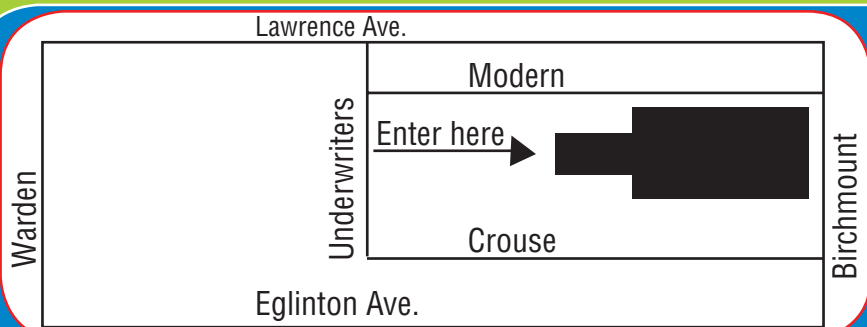

Pickering hospital can't wait to use new dollars

Provincial funding addresses five areas

DURHAM — Although Hume Martin is pleased with the extra money to reduce wait times from the Province, he says there are other areas that could use extra funding too.

"We're very grateful for the ongoing support," said the president and chief executive officer of the Rouge Valley Healthy System.

The Province announced \$39.3 million as part of the second phase of its Wait Times Strategy, which is to improve access to five key health-care services: cataract surgeries, total hip and knee joint

replacements, cancer surgeries, MRI exams and cardiac procedures.

Rouge Valley is getting \$1.115 million. The money means 140 more hip and knee joint replacements, 96 more cataract surgeries and 312 more MRI exams. Joint replacements are done at the Centenary and Ajax sites, while cataract and MRIs are done only at Centenary.

Mr. Martin said those were the amounts the hospital was expecting as the McGuinty government has worked to decrease wait times.

"Clearly this is a very high priority for this government and we as a hospital are trying to assist the government to speed up access for the public," Mr. Martin said.

Children's mental health, emer-

gency room and women's health are other areas where wait times need to be addressed, he said.

"You got to start somewhere and the government is focusing on these five."

Mr. Martin said there should be another announcement soon

about waiting times, detailing how long they are at each hospital.

"What we're going to be looking for is how much variance there is between surgeons in our organization and how do they compare to other systems," he said.

Or at least that's what Pickering council thinks.

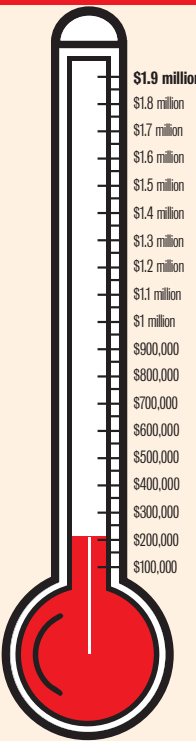

Drug recovery in Pickering

PICKERING — A couple of stray roaches gave away a man who was found to be carrying more than \$200,000 worth of drugs on a Pickering street corner, Durham Regional Police said.

An officer had stopped a man near Whites and Kingston roads Wednesday around 6 p.m. on suspicion of a probation violation and asked him to provide identification.

When the man opened his wallet to retrieve it, two partial-

ly-burned marijuana cigarettes fell out, police said. A search of a duffel bag the man was carrying resulted in the seizure of more than 1,600 grams of crack cocaine, 278 grams of powder cocaine and 115 grams of heroin, police said.

Justin Jamal Hinds, 22, of Lansdowne Avenue in Toronto, is charged with possession of a controlled substance, three counts of possession for the purpose of trafficking, and four counts of breach of probation.

plan to meet with a representative group of Ajax residents. As well, the works department is mailing

out an information letter.
In his report to staff, works commissioner Cliff Curtis said the Ajax works yard at Monarch Avenue and Bayly Street recorded 76 mil-

limetres of rainfall in the one-hour period after 4:15 p.m. Ajax and Pickering received the most rain, but homes on Annes Street south of Dunlop Street also flooded.

Mr. Curtis told councillors that a detailed investigation of what occurred and why, in conjunction with the towns of Ajax and Whitby, could take up to a year.

St. Martin's problems need addressing now

All levels of government are failing residents in the worst way

If it were a private business running things, there would be political hell to pay over the mess at St. Martin's Centre.

Yet, while the Province, Durham Region and a federal agency continue to argue over who's responsible, the centre in Pickering is falling apart.

The roof's in disrepair and leaking, mould has been found in the 58-unit building, water is entering balconies due to a design flaw, and one senior has been moved to a hotel. Oh, did we mention the mortgage could go into default? Generally things are "serious" to put it in the words of the centre's chairman of the board.

Let's put it another way, it's inexcusable. No one deserves to come home to these types of conditions, particularly when we're dealing with a government complex.

So how did we get here? Well there seems to be enough blame to go around. The centre was set up by the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation in the 1980s and downloaded by the Province onto the Region in 2002. Durham contributes \$24,000 annually to the centre's capital reserve but says the Province should pick up the tab for the repairs. Of course, the Province argues it's the Region's responsibility given the annual funding it receives along with \$1.5 million it received recently to deal with federal projects.

So around and around the blame goes. Did we mention we have one person displaced from their home and more could very likely be on the way?

Durham has called for a meeting of regional, provincial and CMHC staff to address the building's problems. It also wants a loan from the Province to get work underway.

At the very least both requests must be met, and fast. But going forward, it's time all three sides set in place a plan that addresses not only the short-term issues, but the long-term capital needs of St. Martin's. All indications are this is just the beginning of the problems and slapping a band-aid on this situation will just ensure more problems down the road. A detailed plan to get the centre on solid financial footing long-term is a must.

It's inexcusable these problems have existed as long as they have. To drag them on any longer would be shameful.

It never ceases to amaze me when I drive by the gas stations these days and see the prices fluctuating.

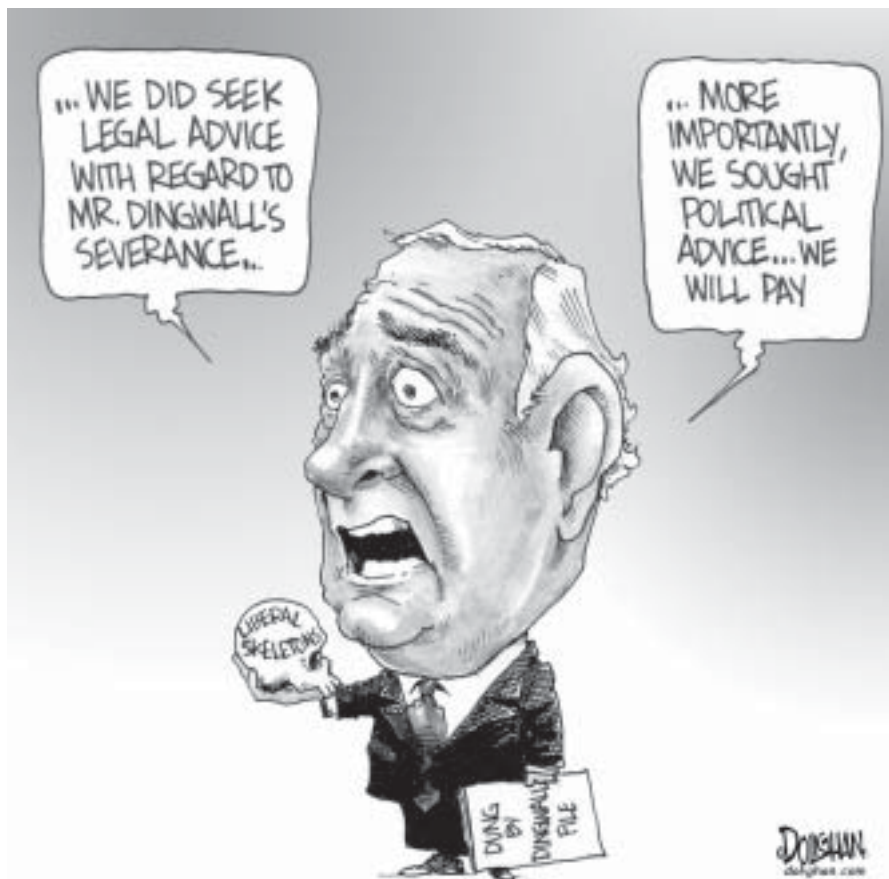

Getting the Attack just right

It will take time, patience to turn junior hockey team around

Believe it or not, the Ajax Attack is making progress, albeit slowly, but progress nonetheless.

With its second win of the season, a 4-0 victory over the North York Rangers on Wednesday night, the OHA Ontario Provincial Junior 'A' Hockey League team has escaped the basement of the South Conference. It's a notable benchmark for a once-downtrodden franchise that spent every day of last season in cellar-dwelling purgatory.

To put it another way, last season's then-Axemen squad won its second and final contest of the season after 29 games; this year's crew managed its first win after only six games and their second after only nine.

That doesn't make the Ajax Attack a good team, but it does instill a measure of confidence that it's moving in the right direction -- something that couldn't be said in past seasons.

To hear Attack head coach Carey Durant say it, he was presented a blank sheet of paper at the outset of camp, and has begun to imprint his philosophy on each of his team members, giving each the blueprint to success in junior 'A' hockey.

"I've got 27 babies," says Durant, alluding to the across-the-board inexperience. "I'm trying to raise 27 kids all at the same time. They are kids and that's the way I have to look at it and do the best job I can do."

"Every game is a test for our team and every game we get better and the players are gaining more maturity."

Durant points out his returning veter-

ans were ones who were under-utilized last season, with those logging the most ice time for the Axemen last season were either shipped off in trades or decided to move on to other programs in the off-season in the wake of the disaster that was the 2004-05 campaign.

The Attack is getting better, but that's not to say there haven't been bumps along the way.

Last Sunday's 10-0 home-ice thumping by the powerhouse St. Michael's Buzzers is something that can, and will, happen. Young players will cough up a furball from time to time. In contrast, however, the Attack played a very strong Vaughan team tough in back-to-back games last week, dropping a 3-2 overtime decision at home last Saturday and, the previous Monday, falling 6-4 on the road.

Despite the ups and downs, winning two of nine games to open the season for an Attack squad that started from Square 1 is more than adequate proof that the junior hockey franchise is pulling itself out of the doldrums.

DURHAM — While her classmates were busy learning Friday, Vanessa Foran was being fitted for her new police uniform.

As the winner of this year's Durham Regional Police Chief for a Day essay contest, the 10-year-old is taking on the honorary role as the region's top cop, Oct. 17.

"I'll remember this for a really long time," said the Whitby girl.

As the honorary chief, she'll be picked up from her school, Florence M. Heard Public School, in a police cruiser and sworn in as chief for the day at the Whitby headquarters. She'll also get a tour of the building and be introduced to various police units.

Along with her uniform and a gift pack, Vanessa and two guests will be VIPs at Durham Region's third annual Police Appreciation Night. There, she'll read her 500-word essay about the role of police officers and how they sometimes have to do things they don't like, such as give people speeding tickets, wear hot uniforms in the summer, and put themselves in dangerous situations for the greater good.

"And we should be respectful to them," said Vanessa.

Without knowing any police officers, it was difficult to write an essay about their responsibilities, she said.

"I came up with these things because I know it's hard to do the right

thing," she said. "I thought really hard and I guess I got the ideas."

Although Vanessa said she didn't think she'd win, her parents encouraged her to participate because she is a good writer.

"And it's a challenge and I like doing things that are a challenge," she said.

She added her best friend said she knew Vanessa would win because of her writing ability.

"I think I might write books when I'm older and I like telling people what to do so I might be a teacher," said Vanessa. "There's so many choices I don't know yet... It's a nice choice to be a police officer, but I don't know if I want to be a police officer."

Vanessa was among five finalists competing in the contest, which was open to all Grade 5 public school students; the contest rotates between the Catholic and public school board. DURHAM — A bee buzzing by a sticky candy wrapper, a packet of peanuts in the lunchroom -- such things can be deadly for some students.

With so many students experiencing life-threatening allergies, Anaphylaxis Canada is holding information sessions across Durham to explain more about the condition and what new provincial legislation, Sabrina's Law, requires from schools.

"The law is a very good and interesting law that has been written," said Marilyn Allen, a founding member of Anaphylaxis Canada who lost her 15-year-old daughter to a peanut butter allergy in 1990.

The anaphylaxis allergy law, effective Jan. 1, 2006, is named after Sabrina Shannon, who died from a dairy allergy at age 13 after eating in a school cafeteria. It requires every school board to establish policies for training school staff to deal with life-threatening allergies, create individual plans for those with them and have emergency procedures in place.

In Durham, school boards already have anaphylaxis policies.

"(Sabrina's Law) has very little impact on Durham district because we are way ahead of the curve on this one," said Mark Joel, the Durham District School Board's superintendent of education-operations, Pickering schools.

He said the board created its policy in 1995 because of the large amount of anaphylaxis students. It includes training staff, emergency plans and an allergy alert form kept in the classroom, which features a

picture of the student, symptoms and medication. Schools also restrict peanuts and some have students eat recess snacks inside to reduce bee sting potential.

Mr. Joel said some schools easily have 10 to 15 kids with an anaphylaxis allergy and the board has never had a death occur at one of its schools.

Although the Durham Catholic District School Board doesn't keep statistics on the number of kids with anaphylaxis allergies, the majority of schools likely have some case of

it, said Mitch LePage, superintendent of education for student services. The Catholic board's policy has been in place since 1998.

"I think this is something that is becoming more prevalent and school boards are becoming more active," said Mr. LePage.

He said along with templates, emergency plans, and other procedures included in the policy, anaphylaxis response is customized as much as possible to each individual's situation.

Although there are some class-

room and school bans on foods, nothing is completely restricted right across the Catholic board.

Along with Sabrina's Law, the anaphylaxis workshops will address misconceptions associated with life-threatening allergies and tips for living a normal life. The anaphylaxis workshops occur Oct. 12 in Pickering at 1792 Liverpool Rd. (time still to be announced), Oct. 13 in Whitby from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m., and Oct. 25 from 7 to 9 p.m. at 30 Kingston Rd. Get with the changes as board gets more hands on with science

DURHAM — 'Climate Change: Impacts and Adaptation in the 21st Century' kicks off this year's SciTech free lecture series.

Entering its third year, the Durham District School Board's series presents Canadian scientists to share their work in a way a textbook can't, said Martin Gabber, programs facilitator for science and technology.

"It provides a whole extra added dimension to the field, it makes it alive," said Mr. Gabber. He said the lectures are general interest and require no scientific knowledge to understand.

The first lecture is from 7:30 to

9 p.m., Thursday, Oct. 13 at the board's Education Centre, 400 Taunton Rd. E. in Whitby. Dr. Paul Gray, climate change co-ordinator for the Ministry of Natural Resources, will present information on current trends and predictions surrounding climate change.

"The whole idea of the lecture series is I wanted to promote sciences," said Mr. Gabber. "I wanted people to have exposure to experienced practitioners in the field."

The annual series has already developed a bit of a following and Mr. Gabber recently received phone calls inquiring if it's running again.

He said everyone is invited to the series, which usually attracts between 80 and 100 people per

session, although there's room for many more.

"We get teachers, we get students, we get members of the general public," he said.

Mr. Gabber said he tries to find speakers on topics of current interest.

"Climate change is a big one right now," he said.

The first lecture discusses known and potential impacts of climate change and some of the things to do and tools to use to support living strategies. Most speakers donate their time, which allows the board to provide lectures for free.

"We've had some pretty good speakers, I've been very pleased," said Mr. Gabber. "Most of the speak-

ers love to come out and talk about what they're doing."

Past presentations included 'Let's Talk About Family Trees... Myths vs Truth' by Joanne Sutherland, a genetics counsellor for the Hospital for Sick Children, and 'SARS, Influenza, Pandemic Flu: What's the next great threat?' by Dr. Donald Low, microbiologist-in-chief for Toronto Medical Laboratories, Mt. Sinai Hospital.

The next lecture in this year's series is Dec. 1. 'Can Cancer Biomarkers Help in the Battle Against Cancer' will be presented by Dr. Eleftherios Diamandis, head of clinical biochemistry, Mt. Sinai Hospital, University Health Network and Toronto Medical Laboratories.

Transit expo delivers ideas for regional system

DURHAM — Maurice Brenner brought some new transit ideas back from Dal-

las. The Pickering regional councillor and co-chairman of the Ajax-Pickering Transit Authority went with regional staff members last week to the American Public Transit Association Expo and Conference. They went to look at new technology for buses, as well as light rail.

"There was a lot of new technology I've never seen before, for example hybrid technology I've never heard discussed up here," he said.

Light rail is an option they gathered a lot of information on, Coun. Brenner said, adding it could be an option for Seaton (the new community in north Pickering that could be home to up to 60,000 people in the next 10 years or so), as well as for connecting Durham with York and Toronto.

"People will use a light rail system if it's convenient, it's faster than a bus," he said, adding people seem to be attracted to packaging.

Another idea he came away with was designing a community around transit instead of the other way around.

"We have an opportunity in Seaton to do it," Coun.

Brenner said.

"It would be foolish to miss an opportunity to do something that's never been done before."

Ward 2 Regional Councillor Bill McLean, who went representing the regional finance committee, also liked that idea.

"It's not going to be cheap, but the benefits down the road will outweigh the costs," he said. "We have to get people out of cars."

Pickering Ward 2 City Councillor Doug Dickerson also attended the conference. He wanted to look at systems to move people from Seaton to the Pickering GO station or out of Durham.

"What I've seen is quantum leaps... It would be ideal at moving large numbers of people in Seaton west to Toronto," Coun. Dickerson said.

The magnetic levitation system (maglev) was one he liked, saying it is timely, clean and comfortable. He said the recent purchase of two new buses by the Region isn't new thinking.

"They're pretty, but they're all archaic. I don't see anything 21st century about them... It really wasn't looking down the road but maybe it's too early," he said.

Cost of the trip was approximately \$1,700 for each councillor.

Super effort in Ajax leads to Super support for Parkinson

Decorating tips: How to show your colours in their best light

One way to avoid costly surprises when decorating, is to remember that colour and light are linked by nature. Every lighting scheme is different and has different effects on paint pigment.

According to Dominique Pépin, member of the Color Marketing Group and Senior Brand Manager at Sico Paints, natural light and your selection of indoor lighting sources will have a huge influence on the



general "mood" created by the colours you've chosen.

Pépin says colours change according to the characteristics of the space they're in, so the best way to check the actual output is in the actual space. "Put your samples right on the walls then change the intensity and angles of your lighting; you'll get a much better idea of the final result."

The three main types of indoor lighting have very different effects on colour. Choosing the right light source will go a long way to helping you achieve the desired effect:

Incandescent light, traditional light bulbs create a warm ambiance but they tend to give a slightly yellow cast to your chosen colours.

Fluorescent light, fluorescent tubes create a cooler mood so colours will have a greenish or bluish tinge.

Halogen lights, new generation of reflectors and bulbs really light up a room. They also allow you to make your lighting more precise or more diffuse, depending on the room. Further, halogen light is similar to natural light; it's neutral so it has very little effect on the appearance of colours.
