New affordable housing units coming to Durham

*Four projects will
see 131 homes built*

*82 units coming to
Station Street in Ajax*

DURHAM — Four projects across Durham Region will provide 131 affordable housing units.

With 3,600 individuals and families on a Regional waiting list, the new units are “very welcome relief for 131 families,” said Oshawa Regional Councillor April Cullen.

The four projects were announced in a ceremony in Ajax Thursday morning, where one development includes an 82-unit building.

The other projects are:
• a \$2.2 million, 32-unit project at 762 King St. E., in Oshawa for low-income families and individuals, including people with physical disabilities and other special needs.

It's sponsored by TGFG Ventures Inc.;

- \$350,000 for five new units in a building at 20 Perry St. in Uxbridge. It will be for low-income seniors and people with disabilities; and,
- an \$840,000, 12-unit project at 229 Lakeview Park Dr. in Oshawa. It's for low-income families and individuals.

The Ajax project, at 40 Station St., will cost \$13.6 million and is for low-income families and individuals, including people with physical disabilities and other special needs.

The four projects are being funded through the Canada-Ontario Affordable Housing Program and are part of \$65 million in initiatives across the province.

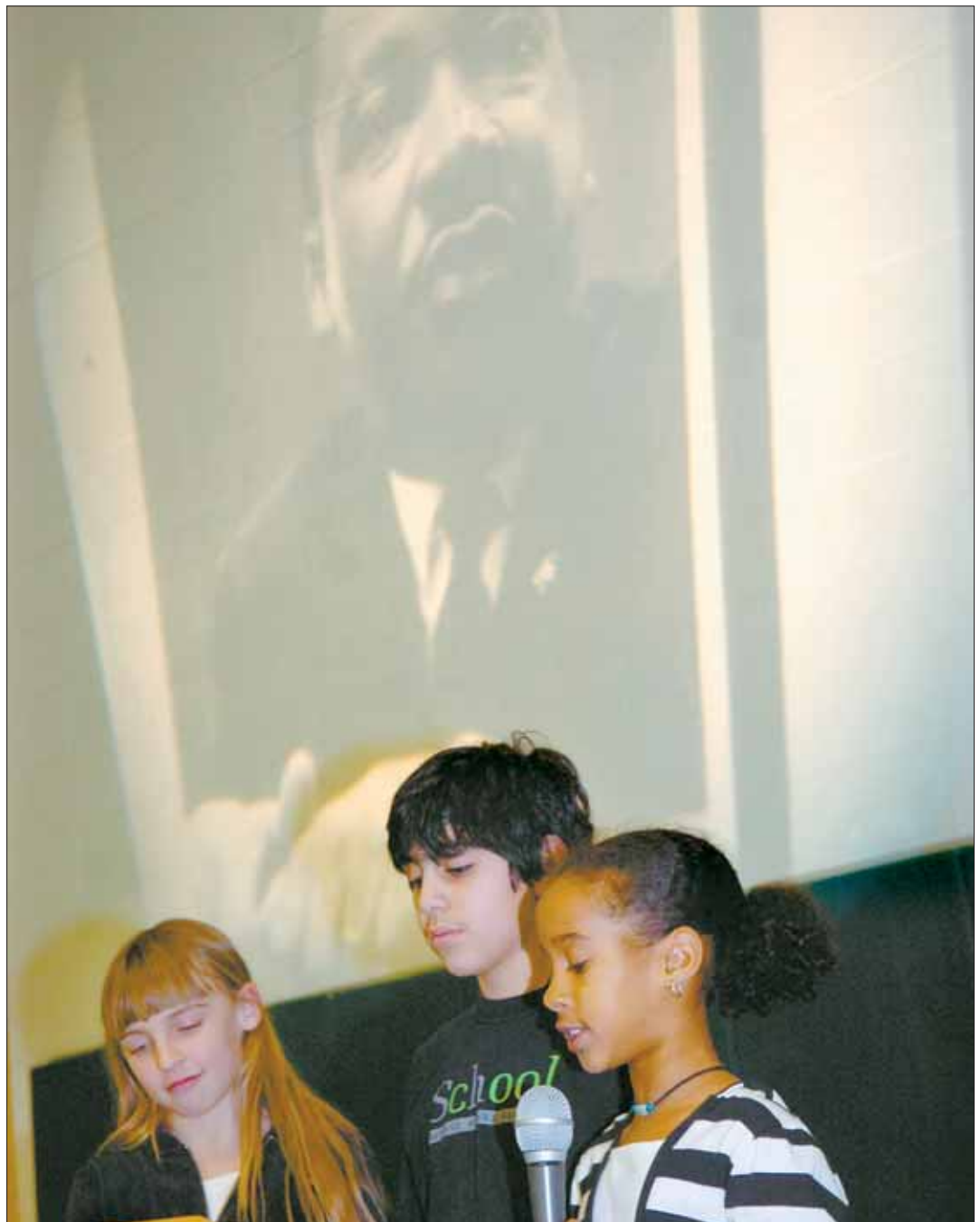

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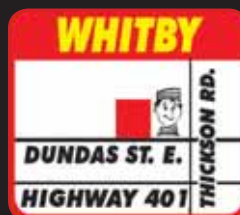
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Pickering man among five charged in real estate scam

Bank defrauded of \$3.8 million

DURHAM — A Pickering man is among several suspects alleged by Toronto police to have conducted a mortgage scam that defrauded investors and a bank.

The man, an employee with the TD Bank, helped would-be investors obtain mortgages for what they thought were condominiums. But the victims actually were buying parking

lot spaces and storage units worth far less, Toronto police said.

The scammers also used information obtained from the victims to fraudulently open business and personal lines of credit, which were then emptied, police said.

Toronto cops say the scam saw the TD Bank defrauded of \$3.8 million.

It's alleged that between 1998 and 2000 two Toronto brothers attracted potential investors for what they said were to be luxury two- and three-bedroom units

on properties they owned in Toronto and Markham. With the help of a real estate agent and two mortgage experts employed by the bank, the brothers helped the investors obtain mortgages, police said; it's alleged the Pickering man was one of those mortgage specialists.

Personal information supplied by victims in obtaining mortgages was used to take out lines of credit, which were maxed out and eventually defaulted, police said.

Charged with fraud and other offences are Patrick

Chan, 61, of Richmond Hill; Lascelles Williams, 36, of Pickering; Saquib Majeed

Baig, 38, of Markham; Steven Mucha, 53, of Toronto, and 70-year-old Ronald Wil-

liams of Mississauga. Warrants have been issued for two other men.

"It's important because it gives youth a chance to connect with each other and support one another in a safe and welcoming

place," says Amy Nagel, a health promoter at The Youth Centre, in a press release.

The program is free and is designed for youth in Ajax-Pickering to be able to drop-in, talk to people, and make friends. Participants are invited to discuss the topics that are important to them. There will also be

guest presenters and days to just watch movies and play games.

The Youth Centre aims to provide a positive environment where youth aged 13-19 can feel free to talk.

The group starts on Jan. 22 at The Youth Centre, 360 Bayly St., Unit 5. It meets every Tuesday from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.

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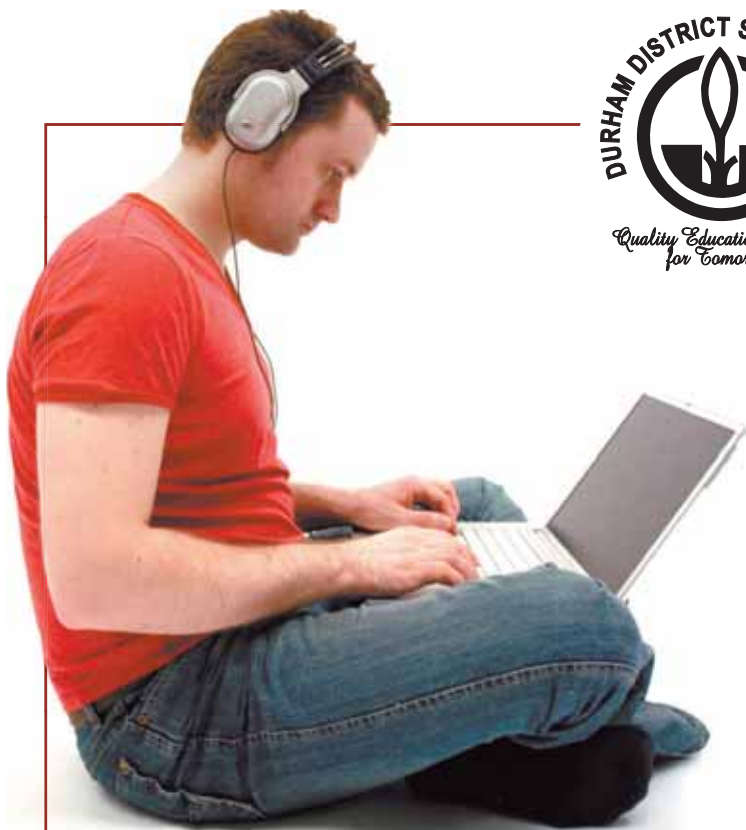
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If you're so inclined, the timing's right to quit smoking

DURHAM — National Non-Smoking Week is this week (Jan. 20 to 26) and area residents are encouraged to take this opportunity to kick the habit.

"Smoking is the No. 1 preventable cause of death and disease," says Durham public health nurse Mary Sue O'Connor. "Decreasing the number of those who smoke will de-

crease death and disease."

A survey conducted by the Health Department indicates close to 17 per cent of area residents smoke daily. The study also says two-thirds of those smokers are considering quitting.

The health department is offering several free programs for those interested in quit-

ting, including a series of education sessions. These hour-long classes cover everything someone needs in order to quit. The sessions help smokers understand the nicotine addiction and encourage the adoption of a plan to quit.

For those looking for more in-depth help with quitting, the health department also has

a six-week series of sessions. There's an information session on Feb. 6 for everyone interested.

The one-hour education sessions and the six-week series are hosted at Durham Regional Headquarters, 605 Rossland Rd. E. in Whitby. For more information call the Durham Health Connection Line at 905-668-6241.

MP for Haliburton-Kawartha Lakes-Brock, said the announcement is a "significant step on building affordable housing here in Durham."

Joe Dickson, the Liberal MPP for Ajax-Pickering, said, "Access to safe and affordable housing is a fundamental necessity. At last, some long overdue work is being done," Mr. Dickson stated.

Jim Watson, the provincial municipal affairs and housing minister, said many people are spending more than half of their income on housing, leaving little money for clothing and food, adding the announcement will "help literally thousands."

Mary Menzies, with the Region's social services department, housing division, said in an interview that last year, "fewer than 50 units were available" for low-income individuals.

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"If your child is not really strong in one subject, like math, he or she probably never will be," he says. "But if they're really good in another area, we should celebrate and promote that."

This may mean dropping the math tutor, for example, to spend more time on English. Ogborne says the important thing is to spend more time on what's working, than what's not.

This month, Pickering Christian School is hosting a seminar that Ogborne hopes will help parents turn around conventional thinking.

Dr. Merry C. Lin, a clinical psychologist in Pickering who works with families and children, will be a guest speaker on January 24. She will talk about how to celebrate and build upon your child's strengths and learning style so that you can help them succeed.

Ogborne says Lin will show parents how to focus on what's right, not what's wrong, with their children's learning.

"So, if your child gets the highest marks in English, you help your child to be the best possible English student they can be," he says. "Soon they'll be in high school and they'll begin to specialize anyway."

Ogborne is not advocating children turn their back on a weaker subject; he says children need a functional level in all subjects, but they can benefit from spending more effort on the areas where they're already achieving.

More than 200 students, from junior kindergarten to grade 8, attend Pickering Christian School at 162 Rossland Rd. East.

The seminar is open to the public and starts at 7:00 p.m. on January 24th. Call Pickering Christian School at (905) 427-3120 for more information.

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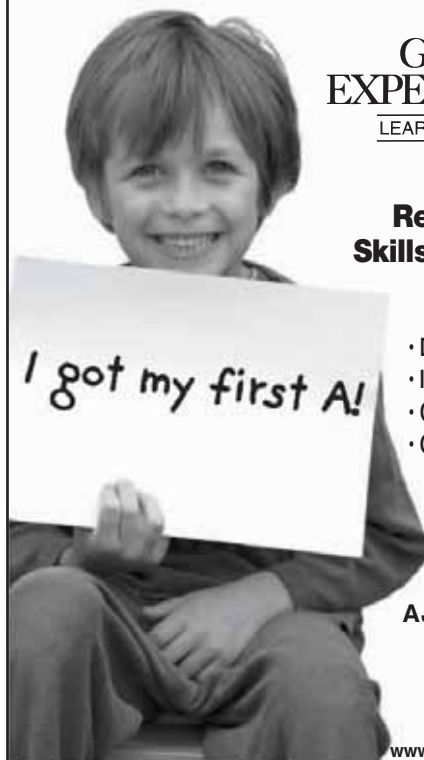
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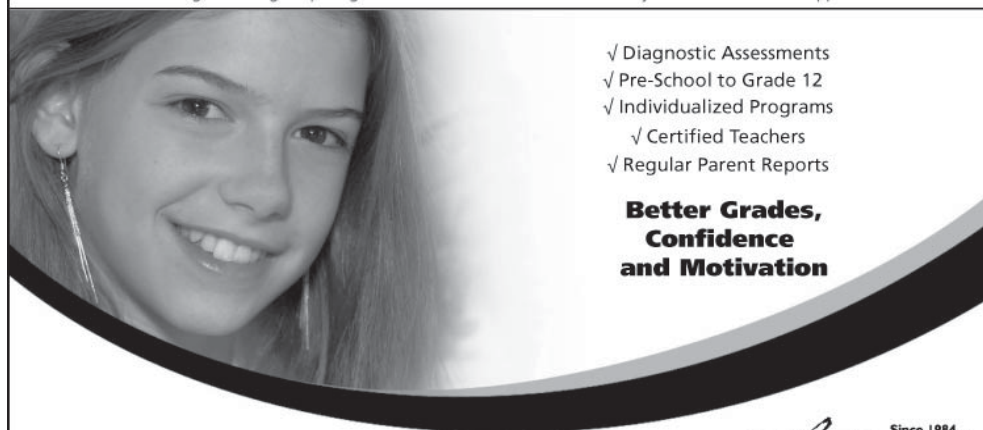

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Affordable housing plan recognizes the needs of most vulnerable

Those who've waited for many years for affordable housing in Durham Region have a reason to smile today. That's because the Province and the federal government have listened to the needs of Durham and are coming through with \$17 million in funding to construct four projects.

The affordable housing will be home to 131 families once complete and will see buildings constructed in Ajax, Oshawa and Uxbridge. The most impressive of the four is an 82-unit, \$13.6-million building at 40

Station St., Ajax, that will target the needs of low-income families, individuals and those with physical disabilities and special needs.

Two projects in Oshawa include a \$2.2-million 32-unit facility at 762 King St. E., and a 12-unit, \$840,000 building at 229 Lakeview Park Dr., in Oshawa.

Uxbridge will get a \$350,000 investment for five new units at 20 Perry St.

The decision to build affordable housing is long overdue and is recognition by upper levels of government that there is a role to play in helping our region's most vulner-

able citizens. Even in the midst of great wealth and prosperity and a housing boom that has lasted for decades, there are too many who still struggle to pay the bills and provide for themselves and their families.

With the feds and the Province running multi-billion-dollar surpluses year after year, there really is no excuse not to pitch in and help out.

Some might suggest the 131 units is a mere drop in the bucket considering there are 3,600 families and individuals on a Regional waiting list. But it's a start and

it's obviously appreciated by April Cullen, chairwoman of the Region's health and social services committee.

The new units are, "very welcome relief for 131 families," she said.

Let's hope the ongoing concerns of those who need help are monitored and closely watched by the feds and the Province. Those in local government are keenly aware of what needs to be done. But municipalities and the Region can't make it happen without a little help from their friends in Toronto and Ottawa.

Incineration debate heating up in Durham Region

When it comes to the debate on incineration, the past couple of weeks have done nothing but add fuel to the fire.

As expected, on Jan. 8, the York-Durham Joint Waste Management Group announced that a Courtice site was the preferred site for an incinerator project.

That was the spark for a flurry of activity that will culminate Wednesday at the Region where council will vote on the site.

The councillors have a mixed bag of recommendations to work with.

The works committees in both regions endorsed the site. But, the next day, Durham's health and social services committee recommended council hold off on selecting a site until a preferred technology is chosen. So far, four of the five options on the table are mass burn technologies. The fifth combines mass burn and gasification.

Clarington's councillors are no barometer by which to measure support for the project either. At a recent meeting, the local councillors were at odds with the regional councillors when it comes to the site selection process. In a 4-3 vote, Clarington council passed a motion asking site selection be delayed. The three voting against the delay, however, are the same three that sit on regional council and the same three who will likely vote in favour of the Courtice site on Wednesday.

Oshawa's Strategic Initiatives Committee has taken the strongest stance so far with a motion that says Oshawa "is not a willing recipient of the wastes and poisons discharged into the air from a proposed incinerator." Among those adopting that motion were four of eight councillors who will vote on the issue on Wednesday.

All that being said, let's be clear. If the incinerator is built, it will be built in Clarington. East Gwillimbury, identified as the second most likely site, doesn't want it.

York Region has reduced its stake in the project to 12 per cent. And, East Gwillim-

bury's council unanimously said in May that it would not be a willing host for such a facility.

Though still ostensibly a partnership, Durham is spearheading this project. If it happens, it will be Durham residents who pick up the majority of the tab. It will be located in Clarington, in Courtice, on a piece of property owned by the Region.

For those who support the project or are still considering its merits, by all means, vote for the site.

But, for those councillors who don't want an incinerator in Courtice, it's time to lay their cards on the table. Delaying site selection won't change anything.

And, finally, let's not delude ourselves into thinking this is an issue for just the people of Clarington. Regional Chairman Roger Anderson is adamant the facility would cost \$150 to \$160 million. Opponents keep throwing out a figure of \$250 million. Either way, it's a costly project and regardless of where Durham residents live, they'll be picking up the tab.

Heading into Wednesday's meeting, the only thing that's certain is the piles of reports, articles, petitions and press releases on this issue amount to a garbage crisis on their own. And, there's surely more to come.

The Raiders' goaltending tandem of Corrigan and Jacob Gordon allowed only 10 goals against for the seven-game tournament.

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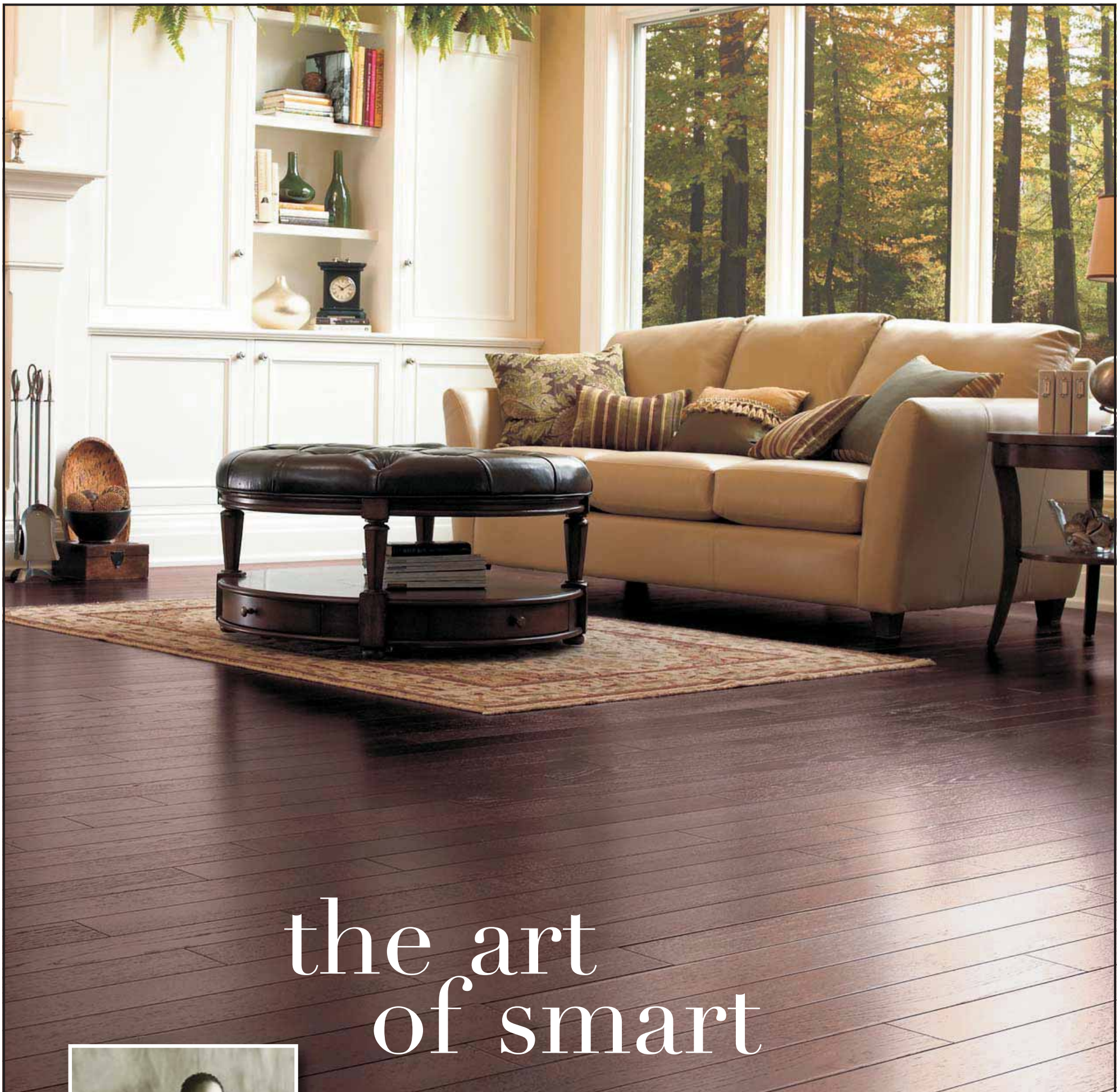
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
