

By-law No. 7875/21

By-law Number 7875/21 will be in full force and effect for the 2026 Municipal Election [see notation below].

By-law Passed: September 27, 2021

Deadline for appeals: November 11, 2021

Note: On November 11, 2021, the City of Pickering received an Appeal for By-law Number 7875/21. Subsection 222(8) of the *Municipal Act* states that a Ward Boundary By-law comes into force on the day the new council of the municipality is organized following the first regular election after the by-law is passed if the by-law is passed before January 1 in the year of the regular election and no notices of appeal are filed, or notices of appeal are filed and are all withdrawn before January 1 in the year of the election, or notices of appeal are filed and the Tribunal issues an order to affirm or amend the by-law before January 1 in the year of the election.

On January 19, 2022, the City was advised by the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) that the Appeal pertaining to By-law Number 7875/21 was withdrawn by the appellant on January 13, 2022. As the appeal was not withdrawn by the date established under the *Municipal Act*, the wards for the City of Pickering will remain unchanged for the 2022 Municipal Election
