Being a By-law to amend Schedule A of By-law 247/75  
regulating the discharge of firearms within the City of  
Pickering

Whereas the purpose of the City of Pickering's Discharge of Firearms By-law is to prohibit the discharge of any gun, firearm, airgun or spring gun or any class or type thereof in populated areas;

Whereas the City's populated areas are identified in Schedule "A" of the existing Discharge of Firearms By-law as of January 21, 1991;

Whereas the populated areas of the City have expanded as a result of residential development that has occurred subsequent to the passage of the Discharge of Firearms By-law, as shown on the map attached to this motion;


Whereas the City of Pickering wishes to ensure the safety of residents by prohibiting the use of firearms in all populated areas; and

Whereas the Discharge of Firearms By-law should be updated accordingly,


Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Pickering hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) Schedule A of By-law 247/75, as amended, is hereby deleted and replaced with Schedule A attached hereto as Attachment No. 2.


